The church office will have a limited number of complimentary tickets available each day for food stand workers to get into the fairgrounds - first come, first served.

GodSpeed Equine Mission Trip

GodSpeed Equine is a nonprofit, Christian-based organization to help abused and neglected youth. They use animals (horses and dogs) as therapy to help heal these young kids. First Lutheran is leading a mission trip on Saturday, August 28th to construct fencing for GodSpeed. We plan to start at 7:30 A.M., working in teams to construct over 8,000 feet of fencing, using what is called continual pipe fencing.

We need 60 dedicated people to come along and enjoy the fellowship, while doing something to help these abused & neglected kids. Our goal is to complete the entire task that day. There are jobs for any age and skill level, including preparing the food for everyone (the food will be simply awesome!). We will have a lot of equipment on sight to help with the heavy work. Do not underestimate your ability to help!

The one tool we need a lot of is cordless impacts. If you have one, or know of someone we can borrow from, PLEASE let me know. We will meet on Sunday, August 22nd to sort out job assignments and go over final details!

When this facility is complete it will be called "Victory Ranch", and it is located at 30151 250th Street, Dallas Center, Iowa 50063. We do have a block of rooms reserved at the Americann in Grimes for anyone wanting to stay the night before. This hotel is about 3 miles from the facility. These rooms will be available on a first come, first served basis until July 25th. Please contact me soon if you desire a room. Also, if you would like to share a ride with someone, please let me know that as well.


