Have you ever stepped into your backyard and taken a moment to admire God’s incredible creation? From the tiny ladybugs on the leaves to the busy bees buzzing through the flowers. God made it all-the vast galaxies and the smallest insects, yet He still cares about you. This summer, we’ll zoom in on God’s greatness and discover how His love and truth are magnified in our lives every day.

Last year, we had 232 kids registered for Vacation Bible School and 76 incredible volunteers! VBS at FBC Lawton is for kiddos that have completed PreK through 5th grade, and this year it will take place beginning **June 23-27th from 9:00am-12:00pm!**

VBS is a unique opportunity to welcome families who may not regularly attend church. It serves as an open door to the community, encouraging families to step inside and experience the love of Christ in a warm, welcoming environment.

VBS is **Christ-led** from start to finish, with every lesson, activity, and interaction pointing kids toward a deeper relationship with Jesus. VBS is fully **gospel centered**—kids hear the message of Jesus clearly and consistently from every teacher, in every rotation, all week long.

It’s more than just fun and games. VBS is a week filled with intentional moments designed to help children grow in their love for God and deepen their understanding of His Word. Above all, VBS is a safe, joyful space where kids can ask questions, build friendships, and experience the love of Christ in ways that are tailored just for them.

VBS takes time, money, and effort—but it is absolutely worth it.

One of my long-term goals is to basically run two VBS programs simultaneously—double the fun and double the impact! But to make that happen, we’ll need twice the number of volunteers. And that’s where you come in! VBS embodies what it means to be **body engaged**—no matter your age or stage of life. There are so many ways to get involved:

- Help decorate or prepare supplies
- Assist in the kitchen
- Drive or be a buddy on the bus
- Welcome families at registration
- Lead kids to their rotations
- Follow up with families
- Invite neighbors or coworkers
- Donate funds for yard signs or banners
- Host a flyer or poster at your business
- Most importantly, **pray**

Even if you can’t physically attend VBS, you can still make an impact—by praying, by giving, or by personally inviting someone!

Isn’t it amazing how often VBS shows up in people’s testimonies? For many who grew up in church, VBS was a key moment in their spiritual journey. For me, it was the first platform God used to grow my calling into children’s ministry. Yes, God absolutely saves kids through VBS, but He also plants seed that grow for years to come.

Let’s make more memories and build kingdom builders this summer at Magnified VBS 2025!



- Pray for our family, ministry, and God’s will to be accomplished for His glory.


