- Cole LaBarre- Had brain surgery causing a stroke, trauma to his left side leaving him blind. Still doing therapy & speech with movement

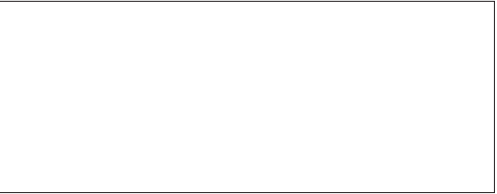
- Levi Taylor- Fell and injured his knee. He is going to have a few intensive surgeries to repair the injured knee. (Son of Troy & LaRae Taylor)
