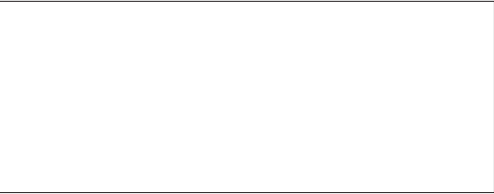

God, Camp, T-Shirts, and Moon Pies

Almost a decade ago, a young businessman went to Falls Creek for the first time. He didn’t grow up Southern Baptist, so he never went to camp as a kid. He grew up writing off camps as feel-good moments that didn’t stick.

When the church he attended started going to camp, he conveniently missed the night of the fundraiser. He didn’t want to give to a cause he thought was fruitless. Years passed and he still never attended the camp.

Eventually through being recruited as a bus driver to events, this young man began to volunteer at youth on Wednesday nights. He was invited to camp as a sponsor numerous times and always laughed at the thought. No one would ever catch him at a youth camp.

Over the course of a couple of years the relationship between the young man and several students began to grow. Those students begged him to go to camp, but he refused. One night sitting in a lonely office with piles of papers, he decided he would drive to Davis the next morning to visit the kids

for just a of couple hours.

Arriving at camp, his presence surprised everyone. The kids were excited,

and he was intrigued to find out what Falls Creek was all about. Despite not being much of a touchy-feely guy, he would later admit that he knew something was different as soon as he drove through the gates.

That night watching close to 7,000 students worship and hundreds respond to the gospel, he knew he had been wrong all those years. He walked outside the cabin that night and called his boss to tell him that he would not be back until next week.

The young man ate like a king that week, received a camp shirt, stayed in a slightly sketchy cabin, worshipped with a world class band, and heard preaching from a nationally recognized speaker, and he had done absolutely nothing to contribute to the experience.

He left camp differently than when he arrived. His first experience

at Falls Creek would be just one of the many dominoes that began to fall, many of which happened at Falls Creek, that eventually would lead him into student ministry.

That young banker was me and I was wrong for not supporting students heading to camp. Things that happen at camp do stick, I am a walking testimony of that and so are 37,000 others who surrendered their lives to ministry at Falls Creek in the past 100 years. In total there have been over 280,000 spiritual decisions, 72,000 of which were professions of faith, at Falls Creek. If you think camp is just free shirts and moon pies, you are as wrong as I was.
