An Apologetics Response

For my apologetic classes in Seminary, we had to watch a lot of YouTube videos from Atheists and Skeptics and write a discussion post based on how we should respond to the Atheist/skeptic. Every video seemed to have two common themes: (1) Church hurt (2) Doubt. Below is one of my responses. I hope it can help you respond better to people who believe differently than you or maybe it might encourage you to seek answers to your doubts about God.

“I am so sorry that you felt so much pressure from the church and people in the church. I also struggle with fear and anxiety of disappointing people. I have found freedom in knowing that what other people think about me at the end of the day does not matter. My worth and value is found in Christ alone. I am who He says I am, not what other people say I am or want me to be.”

“I have also struggled with doubt. The more I studied the Bible the more questions I seemed to have about God and the Bible. One day I was honest with my pastor and told him that I was struggling with doubt,

through the questions I had with no judgment. I realized in this moment that God welcomes our questions about Him and even our doubts about Him because it leads us to seeking Him more. The more I study and read the Word the more affirmed I am in my relationship with God. When we spiral in our doubt and anxiety it leads us away from the Lord, but the Lord never intended for us to do this. He intended that when we have doubts, we spiral upwards towards Him with gentle curiosity.”

Our worldviews are based off of reason and reflection. What has led you to where you are in your life right now? What is your definition of faith and belief? Jamye Dew says that a belief is an idea or concept that we hold to be true. Justification is the reason for thinking the belief is true and truth is the belief that something is actually true. If all of these are true then something is considered knowledge or a justified, true, belief. There was a time in my life when I just had belief in God, but throughout my life I have found justification and

truth in my beliefs. Knowledge of God is possible. God choose to reveal Himself through general and special revelation. Whether we are examining the world around us or the Bible there are many ways that we can discover or encounter knowledge of God. Finally, I encourage you to look at and examine intellectual virtues like humility, honesty, courage, and carefulness. Give yourself the grace to examine your past experiences and why you believe what you believe. Continue to give yourself the freedom to learn and grow and do not give up on the Lord just because of what other people have done or told you.
