Children’s Ministry

According to LifeWay research, there is a 66% church dropout rate of church kids. The average time a child is attending church is only 1.7 times a month. Furthermore, kids are primarily influenced by their peers and screens. Our younger generations need the whole church! The 5th phase is where I came in and I revealed to the team what the Lord had been laying on my heart...we called them “ministry initiatives” to help us reach our goals.
