Almost a decade ago when I really started to dive into the Bible, I didn't know what I was doing. Looking back, saying I didn't know what I was doing feels strange to say. I was raised in church, I had memorized so much Scripture, I knew every story, and I was the Babe Ruth of Bible baseball.

However, all that information floated around in my brain like ingredients for a cake that had yet to be baked. The ingredients on their own are great, but in the right portions, under the right conditions, with a process, and a great baker those ingredients come to life.

In 2016, I enrolled in Biblical Hermeneutics at Oklahoma Baptist University. Honestly, it sounded boring, but in order to get to the apologetics classes I had to survive hermeneutics. As the professor explained the definition of hermeneutics, my mind almost exploded. According to Wayne Grudem, "Hermeneutics is the study of correct methods of interpretation (especially interpretation of Scripture)."

I had no idea there was a way to properly interpret Scripture. I was slightly embarrassed thinking of all the times I had probably missed the mark teaching a text. He then went on to explain another term I had never heard

before, exegesis. Exegesis was the actual practice of applying hermeneutical methodology to a certain passage. Grudem says, "Exegesis is the process of interpreting a text of Scripture."

Throughout that semester all the information floating around in my brain began to connect and it changed from information to knowledge. The Bible had come to life for me and I would never look at Scripture the same.

Since then, my mission has been to make the Bible come alive for students. That vision is shared by our Sunday School Teachers. However, in youth ministry, you often are left wondering if anyone is picking up what you're putting down, but occasionally, the Lord gives us a glimpse of what He is doing.

I got that glimpse a few weeks ago while we were filming some videos for Super Summer. During the filming, I stayed downstairs with the students waiting their turns. Rob Harper and the videographer snagged a couple of students at a time and took them upstairs to film.

We were down to the last student, and I decided to go upstairs and

watch. I sat at the back of the room expecting a few cupcake questions about who you are and why you think camp is important, but to my surprise that's not what I heard.

The first question was about understanding Scripture. The first thing that popped out of our student's mouth was, "Context is everything!" The young lady went on to explain the importance of understanding who the author was, who the audience was, the historical context, the geopolitical context, the geography of the region, the language, how the story fits within the passage, the book, and the Grand Narrative of the Bible. She said, "That makes the text come to life."

I wanted confetti to rain down from the ceiling like the Superbowl. I contained my excitement as I watched her continue to answer questions like she was a 2nd year MDiv student. As soon as she walked out of the room, I ran to Rob and said, "Did you hear how she answered that question?!" He laughed and said, "It's not just her, they all answered those questions the same way." My heart almost burst. I think it's important to share victories with each other and the Bible coming to life for students is always a victory. If you see a Sunday School Teacher this week tell them thank you for pouring into students!
