
**Lodging:** Two Airbnbs in West Jordan.

**Travel Information: We will be flying to and from Utah.**

*We will meet at Will Rogers World Airport on Saturday, July 29<sup>th</sup> @ 5:00am. We are flying Southwest so please enter through those doors.*

*We will meet at the airport lobby and wait for the entire group to be checked in before going thru security.*

**Safety procedures** - We will stay together. If you need to use the restroom, please let Xavier or Alex know. You will need to travel in groups to the restrooms or if you want a snack. Never go anywhere in the airport alone or without telling Xavier or Alex. We do have a layover in Las Vegas and in Phoenix. **PLEASE** do not go anywhere in the airport ALONE. This is very important.

### Unique Features


Utah has incredible natural beauty with its amazing mountain ranges, and is home to some of the kindest people anywhere.
