INTRODUCTION

In almost every area of life, we have seen someone...

... incredibly talented... caring personality... destined for greatness ... so much potential...

And then... BOOM! They fell. They had so much potential, but they were **careless**.

It was not because they lacked skill, but because they lacked character and faithfulness.

This week's hard truth is one the older generation knows very well:

Character and faithfulness are much more valuable than *followers* and *fame*.

1. GOD'S CALLING – A Privilege and Responsibility

1 Samuel 16:7 – “...for the LORD seeth **not as man** seeth... the LORD looketh on **the heart**.”

1 Corinth 4:2 – “Moreover it is **required in stewards**, that a man be found **faithful**.”

Insights:

- ✓ David was not chosen because he was the most impressive; God chose for his heart.
- ✓ Notice that the steward is not praised for being influential, or amazing... but faithful.

Key Truth

- ✓ God is not looking for the most gifted servant, but the most willing and dependable one.
