

First and foremost I want to say thank you. Thank you very much to everyone at both St. John Lutheran and St. Paul Lutheran for supporting me as an intern and a synodically authorized minister during my time here in Northwest Ohio. Thank you for making this a great place to serve, to learn, and to try new things. As I move forward to my call in Northeast Ohio, I feel prepared and ready for what is coming next.

What is coming next? In a letter to the church in Corinth Paul wrote about how we cannot know everything that is and is going to happen: “For now we see only a reflection, as in a mirror, but then we will see face to face. Now I know only in part; then I will know fully, even as I have been fully known” (1 Corinthians 13:12). The truth about what is coming next is that we just do not know.

It is hard to say “I don’t know.” But it is also important and necessary to be able to claim not knowing. When we do, we acknowledge that we are not in control of the future, and that our attempts to take control are not usually the best move for us. When we claim not knowing, we can also claim that it’s because God is the One who knows. When we claim not knowing, we can also claim that the Holy Spirit has a role to play in the future for us— we just don’t know what that looks like yet.

It can be easy to dread the unknowable future. But let’s not forget that it is meant to be exciting and fulfilling for us to orient ourselves to the new thing that God is always doing. And as we all prepare to do something new in 2024, let us remember and embrace the One who knows— our God!
