

We are pleased to announce that we have added two temporary Support Pastors to our staff to help during this time of transition.

Pastor Becky Erb Strang and Vicar Deb Monnin have each agreed to spend 5 hours per week providing pastoral care to our congregation, including visitation. About once a month they will each take a turn serving as our Supply Pastor on Sunday and they will be leading our Lenten services this February/March. We will also be seeing them on Wednesday evenings at W.O.W.

Pastor Becky Erb Strang recently retired from St. Paul UCC in New Bremen, where she served as Senior Pastor for 14 years. She also served as an Associate Pastor in Kettering OH, and Lewisville, TX. Prior to her stint in Texas, she was Director of Youth Ministries in Glenview, IL. Pastor Becky recently started a new post as Director of Partnerships with SOULCHI International, a global startup company focused on making a difference in the world by assisting organizations and individuals to meet the UN's 2030 Sustainable Development Goals. Becky has led church groups to Israel and Kenya and traveled to Indonesia this past October. Becky is also looking forward to engaging with our members and providing pastoral care to those in need. She and her husband Jim recently moved to Celina and already enjoy living in this community. Together, they have two adult sons, Jim and Ben, along with two large dogs and random stray cats.



Vicar/Pastor Deb Monnin is glad to be serving here with St. John. She is a life-long Lutheran, is a second career pastor, and has been a Synodically Authorized Minister (SAM) since 2020 in the Wapakoneta area. She is being called to serve as a Support Pastor anchored with Trinity Lutheran Church in Moulton and will be available to engage the congregations and people in the surrounding communities. Deb's title is "Vicar" for just a few more weeks as a student pastor. After being ordained February 10, 2024, she will then be "Pastor" Deb. She is looking forward to listening to our stories and helping to hear God's call for us and our community. She and her husband Bruce enjoy spending time with their family, doing stats for the Minster High School football team, and helping where they can. 




