Our Spotlight is on... St. John Builders

A Ministry of St. John Lutheran Church, 1100 N. Main, Celina, OH

This ministry of St. John Lutheran Church (The Purple Door Church) exists to help those in need by providing low-income housing and/or modifications to existing residences, such as wheelchair ramps. Their projects vary according to the needs. But their beginnings were varied and a true service to others!



HOW DID THE ST. JOHN BUILDERS GET STARTED?

About 1989, Paul Stein, Bob Chaney, Jerry Weisman and Pastor Doug Meyer made several trips to Lima Habitat to help build 3-4 houses. Then they traveled to Evansville, Indiana and worked to finish 4 houses.

After these projects, these 4 men met and decided that they could serve our area in the same way. St. John Builders, a group of volunteers with a desire to help others, was formed.

To build their first house, they needed to raise funds and locate a building lot. Ralph Heffner, a late member of St. John Lutheran, donated a 5-acre lot in Neptune. In the ensuing years, they worked to raise funds for building materials, re-roofing local homes, making birdhouse kits for sale, whatever it took to raise funds to start building a house in Neptune for a family in need. An anonymous member of the church offered to finance needed funds, interest-free, to build a second house in Neptune. The Builders repaid that loan.



WHAT HAVE THEY ACCOMPLISHED?

It's amazing how much the Builders and other volunteers have accomplished and how many lives they have impacted.

- In 1990, they, along with approximately 50 other church members and friends traveled to Cross, South Carolina to build a house after Hurricane Hugo did its damage.
- During the years 2006-2008, the Builders and other churches traveled to Mississippi several times to build or repair homes affected by Hurricane Katrina.
- Fifteen families have been blessed with homes in our local area.
- They built the House of Hope and 2 cabins in the Hand-Up Village, both in Celina.
- They have also built or worked on homes in St. Anthony and Spencerville.

- CALL Food Pantry was remodeled as was the Choosing Life Pregnancy Center in Celina.
- For the church, the Builders created the maintenance building (due to the addition of the Family Life Center) and their own storage and workshop building.
- Several wheelchair ramps have been made and installed for local families.
- Each summer, Builders travel to a variety of church camps and spend 2-3 weeks working at the camps.
- See the trees around the church? They weren't always there! The Builders started a tree garden on the church property and sold enough trees to others to pay to have several trees moved and placed around the church!

IN 2023 ALONE, THE BUILDERS

- ✓ built a new home for a family, repurposed a SJB home after the owner passed away,
- ✓ built 12 wheelchair ramps and removed 2 ramps that were no longer needed,
- ✓ held a 127 garage sale event and hosted the annual ice cream social,
- ✓ picked up furniture and other items donated by families in various communities at least 19 times, which the Builders could sell at the 127 garage sale or to other interested persons.

AN APPLICATION PROCESS is designed to find families who qualify to purchase a Builders' home. Applications are reviewed by a committee of several community members and shared with the Builders. Recipient families are expected to put in some man-hours as the house is being built.

The Builders operate with donations, grants, fundraising events and house payments from the families who purchased a SJB home.



WHAT CAN YOU DO?

Volunteers are always welcome! If you cannot help on projects or attend a SJB meeting, volunteers are always welcome and needed for our annual fundraising events.

Bring your family and friends to our **annual ice cream social in July each year!** In early August, check out our **127 Garage Sale**. We might have something you need as we sell excess building materials and/or donated items.

Thanks to our St. John Lutheran Church family and other community churches, businesses and friends for their on-going support. Without you, we could not do what we do!



Opening: Brian Miller called the meeting to order, and Pam Rasawehr gave devotions.

- A decision was made to alter the church office hours effective March 1st. The office will be staffed and open Monday, Tuesday and Thursday 9am-4:30pm. Wednesday's hours are being changed to 12:00pm-7:30pm to provide a staffed office during W.O.W programs.
- The next council meeting was scheduled for February 20th at 6:30pm.

Executive Session:

Council entered into executive session for approximately an hour.

After returning from executive session, motions were made to adjust the wages of two staff members. The first motion was made by Pam Rasawehr and seconded by Jennifer Barrett, motion carried. The second motion was made by Jennifer Barrett and seconded by Shane Stachler, motion carried.

February 22, 2024

Opening: Jennifer Barrett called the meeting to order and offered devotions.

Financial Report: A review of a summary of the January financial report, which showed giving for the month increased. A motion to approve was made by Chad Sapp, seconded by Pam Rasawehr. Motion carried.

Property: Jenelle Gross informed the council of an inspection by the local fire department. It was noted that the extension cords used on the lights strung up in fellowship hall need updated. She also noted that the AED-First Aid kits need updated. Jenelle also reported that the laminator in her office started smoking and she was able to get it safely out of the building. She found that the laminator had been recalled; thus, she reported it and will be reimbursed by the company.

Old Business: Ingrid Tebbe noted that the Synod assembly, which is held every 2 years, will be in Bowling Green, OH, on June 1. Lay persons, youth and pastors are encouraged to attend. There is an application process for those interested in attending.

Council needs to look into safety training for all staff.

Volunteers and lay assistants are needed to serve in all positions – readers, ushers, welcome committee, communion assistants, helping with projects during the week (children’s programs, youth activities, etc.). Everyone is encouraged to offer these opportunities to serve to others who don’t know about them.

If anyone has the desire to serve as a pastor or synodically authorized minister (SAM – lay person), they are encouraged to make their wishes known to council. The church offers financial and other support for training.
