When Stephen Ministry was founded in 1975 it was, in part, as a way to allow a young minister be more effective in his work. The minister came to realize that there were many more needs for care in his congregation, in St. Louis, than he could possibly meet alone. So he equipped nine parishioners as the first “Stephen Ministers”, who helped him meet caring needs in the church and community.

The ministry was so successful that he founded a not-for-profit Stephen Ministries organization as a way to bring Stephen Ministry to other congregations. Today there are over 13,000 congregations around the world that have Stephen Ministries, of which we are one.

Pastors are always the frontline caregivers in a congregation, but they only have so much time in a week to do all of the many things they have to do to make a church work for the people. Well-trained and supervised Stephen Ministers are able to provide emotional and spiritual care for people dealing with a wide range of life difficulties. Some of them are:

- Grief
- A major medical crisis
- Job Loss
- Divorce, break up, broken relationships
- Pregnancy, birth, post-birth challenges
- Infertility, miscarriage
- Family caregiver stress
- End of life, hospice
- Long-term illness, chronic condition, disability
- Financial difficulties
- Major life transition (relocation, empty nest, retirement, move to assisted living)
- Military deployment of a loved one
- The aftermath of a natural or human-caused disaster

Through Stephen Ministry, people experiencing these types of crises can receive excellent care for as long as needed.



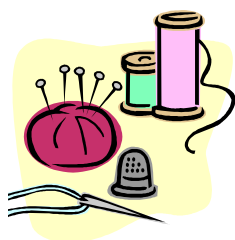
“BABY SHOWER FOR JESUS”
