My beloved community, I share this news feeling gratitude, hope, and genuine sadness. It is time for me to step aside as your pastor. My last Sunday in this community will be July 9th. I could not be more grateful for all of you and our ministry together over these 12 years. With God's help, we have done incredible work in the Lord's name. You have invited me into your lives and loved me, and I am thankful for each of you.

You are a remarkable community of faith, with vision, compassionate ministries, strong leadership, deep trust in God's grace, and a humble willingness to risk and change for the sake of our neighbors and the Gospel. You are the church! Continue to generously give of yourselves to ***Make the Love of Christ Known***.

I tendered my resignation on Monday evening to the Board of St. Paul, North Star.
I tendered my resignation Tuesday evening to the Board of St. John, Celina.
Below is the resignation letter to St. John.

May 23, 2023

In 1870 God began something new in Celina. Since its beginning, St. John Lutheran Church's ministry has served individuals, families, the community, other congregations, our great nation, and the world. This has been and will continue to be a powerful ministry, done in the Lord's name. Thank you for welcoming my family into the Purple Door family, and allowing us to serve our Lord alongside you. We have been blessed in coming to know and love you all!

Twelve years ago, you and God called me to serve as your pastor. My time here feels short for a ministry that spans well over 150 years. We've worshiped, prayed, worked, served, played, laughed, and cried together. For twelve years, you have inspired and loved me.

There is so much potential here at St. John; God is clearly on the move. But for me, my spiritual, emotional and physical tank is empty. It is time for me to step aside for a pastor with new vision and new energy to lead this ministry. Sunday, July 9, will be my last Sunday at St. John. I have accepted a new call to serve Trinity Lutheran Church in Midland, Michigan. Beyond July 9, I can no longer preside over any pastoral acts (worship, baptisms, weddings, funerals, home visitations). This will not be easy, but we trust it is in the best interest of God's church.

I am excited to watch God's future for St John unfold as you, the church, continue to engage in impactful mission and ministry. It has been a privilege to work beside all of you in ministry. God has gathered a fantastic staff of committed, faithful and talented individuals; continue to love, support, and pray for them. God continues to lift passionate lay leaders in this

congregation; love, support, and pray for them. And, of course, the church cannot live out the Gospel without the hands and hearts of all God's people. You are the church! Continue to generously give of yourselves to Make the Love of Christ Known.

Looking forward:

Long ago, Liz and I scheduled some vacation time at the beginning of June; we plan to take this vacation. Also, from June 11-16, I will be with our confirmation students at camp; I plan to keep this promise to our students. Outside of these two commitments, until July 9, I will continue to be present with you, worship with you, and serve alongside you.

As I move to Michigan, we have a unique family situation: Liz and Grace have decided to remain in Celina for one more academic year. This will allow Grace to graduate from Celina High School and let Liz teach at the Lake Campus of Wright State University for one more year. Liz hopes to remain a worshipper at St. John but needs to stop her volunteer work at the church. Grace wishes to stay a worshipper at St. John and remain an active member of the Youth Group.

The bishop's office will guide the congregation in discovering the pastor God is preparing for this great congregation.

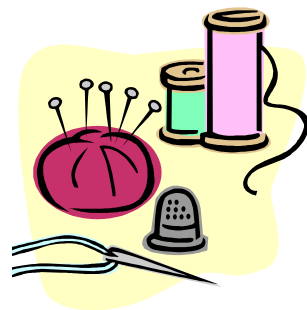
