Church Council Meeting
6:30 p.m., Tuesday, July 17, 2024

Present: Jennifer Barrett, Diane Menchhofer, Pam Rasaweher, Shane Stachler, Chad Sapp, Don Trisel, Pastor Jeff Bunke, and Mike Overman for Stephen Ministries

Opening: Jennifer Barrett called the meeting to order and offered devotions.

Approval of June meeting minutes: Minutes were amended to state that the motion to pay contemporary performers (\$50 each per week for up to 4 performers) and an interim leader (\$100 per week), was effective as of June 23. Pam made a motion to approve the amended minutes, seconded by Shane. Motion carried.

Committee Reports:

- The Worship team met June 26. A group of 20 (including altar guild, musicians, ushers, Pastor Deb Monnin and others) brainstormed ideas to improve worship experiences. They will meet again on August 21.

Stephen Ministries: Mike Overman shared about being “Lookouts”, helping identify people who are hurting and connecting them to the Stephen Ministers. All connections and discussions are totally confidential. Someone in need could be experiencing difficult times, such deaths, divorce, job loss, or transitional events, such as birth of a child or marriage. Mike provided contact information for Linda Siebert (419-852-2102) and him (419-953-7370).

Support Pastors’ Reports: Monthly reports from our three support pastors were shared. Pastor Jeff Bunke shared about the upcoming Stewardship schedule. The three pastors will hold a zoom meeting Friday, July 19.

Business Manager’s Report: Don Trisel presented the June financial reports. Shane Stachler made a motion to to accept, Chad Sapp seconded. Motion carried.

In order to make council meeting minutes available to the congregation on a timely basis, Don posted June’s minutes on the E-Blast and on the bulletin board by his office and did receive some feedback, which he addressed.

- Vacation Bible School will be July 29-August 1, throughout the church.
- A couple community events are coming up in August. August 5 the Solvita Blood Drive will be held in the Family Life Center. The Solvita Blood Center provides blood supplies to Mercer Health. On August 19, Lifeline Screening will be held in the fellowship hall.

Don reported that the south driveway (Myers Rd.) should be back open soon. The church is then responsible for installing the sidewalk. Donations are requested to help cover the costs of this project. He also provided council with information and options on increasing our security camera coverage within and outside the church building.

President’s Report: Jennifer reported that the New Member Class, held July 10, went well. Three people were in attendance, and one person contacted her later.

Unfinished Business: The Board of Elections has requested that we agree to be an emergency polling place, which would be in the Family Life Center. Chad made a motion to agree, seconded by Pam. Motion carried.

New Business:

- Don shared that our former business manager, Romana Kieti’s husband passed away. He will share more information as he receives it.
- Council will work on descriptions of new committees and goals for each one. Once established, it is recommended that personal contact be made to prospective committee members and share the purpose of each committee.
- Our church database needs updated and then maintained by our next administrative assistant (formerly receptionist position). Council will request some members of the congregation to assist with this project.

Executive Session: Council entered executive session at 7:48 p.m. and exited at 9:09 p.m.

New Business Continued: Pam made a motion to add 2 cameras to the security system. Shane seconded. Motion carried.

Adjournment and Prayer: Chad made a motion to adjourn at 9:12 p.m., seconded by Diane. Motion carried. Council closed with the Lord’s Prayer.

The next council meeting will be Tuesday, August 27, 6:30 p.m. at North Star.

UPDATE ON CHURCH SIDEWALK PROJECT:

Our portion of the sidewalk project was completed recently. We thank KLS Construction for their quick and skillful work. The city still needs to finish the corner sidewalk and crosswalk at the traffic light. We are still accepting special donations to help with our sidewalk project, which had a total cost of \$24,300. As of 8/20/2024 we have raised \$8,285 specifically for this sidewalk project. Thank you for your contributions!

At the November 2023 Congregational Meeting, we voted to pay for this project from our Capital Improvement Fund. After paying the sidewalk bill and adding contributions received in August so far, the balance in the Capital Improvement Fund stands at approximately \$71,075 as of 8/20/2024. The official account balance will be available after the end of the month.



Report on the 2024

ELCA Youth Gathering in New Orleans

On July 16, seven youth and two adults from St. John Lutheran Church headed to New Orleans for the first ELCA Youth Gathering since 2018. We joined thousands of high school youth from across the US for a week of learning, worship, Bible study, service and fellowship in the historic city.

For most of these youth, this is the first and only opportunity they will have to attend a Youth Gathering. Not only does this event only take place every three years, but it requires an immense amount of planning, coordinating, and financial support. For all of the group, it was their first time in New Orleans. For some, it was their first time on a plane! It was a joyful week of firsts—one made possible by the great love and support of our congregation.

In the weeks leading up to the trip, many members shared with us memories of their own Gatherings, tales of long drives and broken-down buses, but also of deeply meaningful fellowship and faith formation. And as we



return home, we carry with us our own memories of long, hot walks, torrential rain, early mornings, late nights, new friends, new foods (alligator *does* taste like chicken!), and a whole lot of reasons to give thanks to God. It was our theme verse for the week that said it best:

*I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made.
Wonderful are your works; that I know very well. (Psalm 139)*

To be in that arena with 16,000 people, worshiping, praying, and communing together, is to know that the works of God are truly wonderful. And to know this group of young women from our church is to know that they are fearfully and wonderfully made.

What are Stephen Ministers? They are trained individuals who provide high-quality, confidential, Christian care and support to people experiencing grief, divorce, cancer, job loss, loneliness, disability, relocation, and other life difficulties. They are not counselors or pastors – they mostly provide compassion, listening intently and sharing the sorrows and joys of those they care for. They refer them to other kinds of caregivers as needed. A Stephen Minister will spend about an hour a week with someone in need, listening, being supportive, and perhaps praying and sharing a passage from the Bible.

We are fortunate to have the following Stephen Ministers supported and commissioned by St. John Lutheran Church: Tim Menchhofer, Ed Fuelling, Paul Czernik and Sue Buxton. We are also thankful for our Stephen Ministry Leaders, Linda Siebert (419-852-2102) and Mike Overman (419-953-7370).
