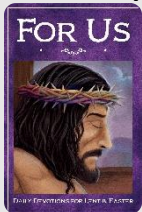

For more than 17 years, Emmanuel's Food Bank has served families in our congregation and community, assisting an average of 40 families each month with food, personal hygiene items, and household supplies. ### Euchre Tournament

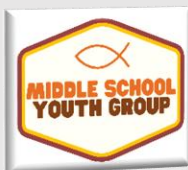

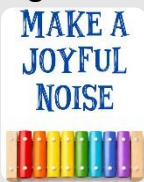

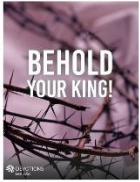
