13% of rescue Teams

7% firefighters

5% police offices

I would like to take just a couple of minutes to introduce myself to you. My name is David Carter, I am the Youth Pastor at One Accord Community Church.

I have also been in emergency services for 41 years. I have served in a variety of rolls to include firefighter, EMT, Paramedic, and Critical Care Paramedic. I have served as a ground medic, Shift Capt., Training Officer, and EMS Director. I tell you this so you will know that I have been there. I have had most of the stresses that you guys have gone through. I have had those calls where everything was great and could not have gone any better and the outcome was amazing. I have also had those calls where things could have not gone worse no matter how hard we tried. I have had to tell the little grandmother that her husband of 50 was dead. When I had just started I had to put my classmate in a body bag because he shot himself. I have witnessed human beings traumatized and torn apart in ways that were indescribable.

I have put both elderly and infants in body bags. It has effected my personal life and my family. I have been puked on, bleed on, and shot at. I have went through two divorces. I have made some very dear friend and have also lost some dear friends.

I know what I just wrote could be depressing, but there is a light and that light is Jesus Christ. He is the reason I am still here on this earth. He is the only way I could have gotten through all the garbage that I have went through.

With that being said our goal here at One Accord is to give you a safe place with no judgment and no preconceived notions, for you to come and unwind. To share a meal or just a cup of coffee with others in the same situation that you are in, or have gone through.
