 - We believe we must share the gospel through mission action and witness.



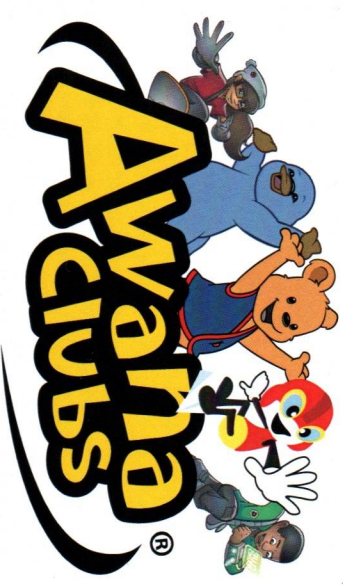
