

## **EHBC Ministry Residency**

### Purpose:

The EHBC Residency exists to train men and women in the church by striving to teach theology, practical ministry, and patterns of discipline and service, with the aim that they would be better prepared to glorify God in future faithful ministry.

### Length:

30 weeks (15 each semester) 14 weeks of content each semester, plus an evaluation.

### Requirements:

Must be an EHBC Member for at least 6 months prior to start of program (Must have been a member by February of the year of the program).

### Learning Objectives:

Ecclesiology

Personal Holiness/Disciplines

Preaching/Teaching

Systematic Theology

Church History

Church-wide Practical Theology

### Description:

Residents will be involved in a weekly meeting to discuss assigned material over learning objectives with Parker, other residents, Elders, and guest teachers.

### Included Assignments:

- Individual Belief Statement
- During Semester 1, randomly draw out one of the colored 9marks books and lead a discussion on it.
- During Semester 2:
  - Pick two of the small CCEF resources and write a reflection over each and prepare to present them for discussion with the other residents during Week 12.
  - Pick two apologetic topics (approved by Parker) and write a reflection on each and prepare to present them for discussion with the other residents during Week 13.
  - Pick one of the 27 Servants that isn't covered in the residency and write a reflection on him and prepare to present them for discussion with the other residents during Week 14.
- Lead a devo at the start of each session.
- Semester Evaluation - At the end of each semester, Parker and the EHBC elders will meet with each resident.
- Monthly Meeting With Assigned Leader - Each resident is responsible to set a meeting once a month with an assigned elder or church leader (They will have the same elder/leader all year).

- Response papers to readings
  - Semester 1
    - Each week, residents will bring a 1-2 page single-spaced paper (no particular formatting) with section that includes a summary and reflection, prioritizing critical/thoughtful interaction, on each of the primary readings (Dever, Whitney, and Biographies). (1 paper with a section for each reading. Example: 1 section over the chapter from Whitney, 1 section over the chapter from Dever, and 1 section over the chapter from Piper.)
    - Write an additional 1 page single-spaced summary and response for all other readings assigned (Example: 1 section summarizing and reflecting on Men and Women in the Church - Deyoung)
  - Semester 2
    - Each week, residents will bring a 1-2 page single-spaced paper (no particular formatting) with a section that includes a summary and reflection, prioritizing critical/thoughtful interaction, on each of the primary readings (Allison and Biographies). (1 paper with a section for each reading)
    - Write an additional 1 page single-spaced summary and response for all additional readings assigned (Example: 1 paper summarizing and reflecting on both Shaw and Nichols)

Included Involvements:

- Once a week meeting for 3-4 hours (Monday 11am-3pm)
  - Attendance is mandatory outside of approved absence
- Preaching Practicum for male residents
- Prayer Meeting - 8:15 Sunday Mornings
- Staff meetings when possible
- Ministry involvement (childrens, youth, welcome, etc)
