Altar Guild Guidelines

After service, when Pastor and the Elders are done taking care of the consecrated wine and bread, collect the communion ware (Chalice, Flagon, and Paten) to be cleaned.

In the kitchen, be sure to use the tubs marked “Communion use only” and the supplies (drying mat and cleaning cloths therein). When finished cleaning, the water used should be poured outside onto the grass, NOT down the sink. Return tubs and mat to the cupboard. Cleaning cloths should be taken home to be laundered separately from family laundry.

Arrange the cleaned communion ware on the Credence table and drape the Post Communion veil over the Communion ware.

Wipe and tidy the Sacristy counter.

Additionally, check the Altar linens to be sure that they are spotless. Replace with clean ones if needed. Clean fare linens and Corporals are in the Parament closet. (You will need the key from the office if you do not have one.) Purificators are in the sacristy drawer.

The linens that are soiled should be taken home and washed separately from family laundry. **Before laundering, remove wine stains with a paper towel and then burn the paper towel that you used.** The Fare linen can be taken to a dry cleaner to be cleaned and pressed. **Pleasant hill cleaners have done an excellent job cleaning and pressing without tagging the linens (tagging puts a hole in them).**

As Needed:

Vacuum the Chancel

Empty the trash bin in the Sacristy

Restock Sacristy supplies (paper towels, hand sanitizer, and disinfectant wipes).

Clean the brass candle tips and the candle snuffers

Wipe out the wine fridge

Elder Guidelines

1. The Board of Elders shall consist of at least four (4) men.
2. The term of office for an Elder shall be for two years, preferably with at least one-half of the Board elected each year. He may succeed himself with one two-year term.
3. The Board of Elders shall consist of one man for each fifteen (15) families of the congregation.
4. One Elder shall be Chairman of the Elders and be the representative on the Church Council.
5. They "shall hold up the arms" of their pastor through prayers, support, encouragement, advice, recommendations, and assistance.
6. They shall be concerned for the welfare of the pastor and his family, see to it that the called servants of the Word receive adequate salaries with at least annual reviews of salary.
7. They shall be responsible for the worship services, giving attention to:
 - a) time and schedule
 - b) attendance
 - c) special services
 - d) altar and pulpit supply
 - e) order and dignity
 - f) greeting visitors and new members
 - g) baptism and holy communion
 - h) ushering
 - i) music
 - j) care and use of the church building with special focus on use of the sanctuary.
8. They shall gather information and follow up regarding church attendance and use of the Sacraments by the members.
9. They shall
 - a) Take note of and convey known and/or requested pastoral care needs of church members to the pastor, with each elder paying particular attention to those families included on their respective Family List.
 - b) communicate with and encourage the pastor to ensure that proper pastoral care is provided to those in need in a timely manner.
 - c) accompany the pastor on personal/family visits as needed and/or requested by church members and/or the pastor.
10. They shall show concern for the orientation and integration of new members into the life and work of the church.
11. They shall ensure that pastoral care is available to church members when a pastoral vacancy occurs, when Pastor is sick, on vacation, or away on other business of the congregation.
12. In short, together with the pastor, the Board of Elders is concerned with the spiritual welfare of the entire congregation.

Greeter Guidelines

Greeters welcome members and visitors on Sunday mornings. When the weather allows, you can greet people at the door. Specifically, identify visitors and encourage them to sign the guest book and make sure they pick up a yellow information sheet. If they are new to the Divine Service, you may also give them the “Simple Explanation of the Church Service” booklet, or verbally share with them tips to following along. Assist visitors in finding Pastor or an Elder to speak to them about Communion practices.

Streaming Guidelines

Streaming the Divine Service:

Time commitment: The duration of a divine service, once a month

Skills needed: minimal computer skills helpful, ability to go up the balcony stairs

Training: training will be provided and instruction manual is available in the balcony

The streamer serves one Sunday a month during the divine service. Starting about 15 minutes before the service begins, the streamer verifies that the slide show being used matches the hymns and readings posted in the bulletin and checks to make sure cameras and microphones are working. 5-10 minutes before the service, they press the record/stream button which begins the streaming process. During the service, the streamer advances the slides of a prepared slide show which provides viewers with readings, hymns and copyright information. In addition, the streamer controls the camera view alternating between the zoom camera view and the wide view. Finally, the streamer alternates the microphones from the congregational microphones to the lectern/pulpit microphones using a simple touch of a button. At the conclusion of the service, the streamer ends the recording and shuts off the video camera. Almost everything is done by pressing a button on a control panel and following on screen instructions and guided by the instruction manual. See Jeremiah Bolin for details or training.

Usher Guidelines

General Overview of the Duties of the Church Usher:

1. The usher, being a servant of Christ and His body, should consider it an honor and a serious Responsibility to assist the pastor and elders in preparation for the Divine service.
2. Ushers NEED to be at the church 30 minutes before the service begins.
3. The usher's appearance should be appropriate to the reverence due the Divine Service.
4. Ushers should participate in the service. Therefore, after the service begins, the ushers are encouraged to sit with their family.
5. If you are signed up to usher on Sunday, you are expected to also usher at any special services (i.e. Advent and Lenten services) during the coming week.
6. If you are unable to usher after you have signed up, please find a replacement or talk to the pastor or one of the elders so a replacement may be found.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities of the Usher during the Service:

1. Help maintain good order in case of an emergency. (i.e. Call 911 in case of an emergency and help congregation as necessary).
2. Ensure the hymns are correctly posted on the hymn boards.
3. Ensure the pews are tidy and straightened up before the service.
4. Ensure the lights, sound system and air conditioning are set properly.
5. Speak with the pastor or an elder to see if there are any special instructions prior to the service.
6. Be of assistance to visitors and members when needed. Specifically:
 - a. Distribute Service Bulletins and make more copies if necessary.
 - b. Direct visitors to an elder or pastor if they desire to receive Holy Communion.
 - c. Help people find a place to sit if the sanctuary is crowded.
7. Bring Pastor the offering
8. Before and after Holy Communion, ushers should be available to install and remove the Communion rail.

Responsibilities after the Service:

1. Organize and tidy up the sanctuary and pews including:
 - a. Straightening up pew hymnals and Bibles.
 - b. Checking for any lost or forgotten personal items in the pews.
 - c. Turn off lights and the sound system
 - d. Check the thermostat is at the correct setting.

If you have any questions, please speak with Pastor or one of the Elders. Thank you for volunteering for this important job of helping ensure the service runs smoothly and in good order.
