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# A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church Family,

February can be a cold and quiet time of the year. There are seasons in life—and in faith—that feel like that—Cold. Quiet. Slow. In *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe*, C.S. Lewis describes Narnia under the spell of the White Witch as a place of “always winter, but never Christmas.” It’s a haunting picture—endless cold with no sign of celebration or renewal.

Many of us know what that feels like. We keep showing up. We keep praying. We keep doing the next faithful thing, even when warmth and fruit seem far off. Scripture reminds us that God often works most deeply in these very seasons, when perseverance matters more than excitement and trust matters more than visible results.

Years ago, during my fraternity pledgship in college, I had to memorize a quote by Calvin Coolidge that has stayed with me ever since: “Nothing in this world can take the place of persistence. Talent will not; nothing is more common than unsuccessful men with talent. Genius will not; unrewarded genius is almost a proverb. Education will not. The world is full of educated derelicts.” Persistence – the quiet resolve to press on – is often what God uses to shape His people.



Winter does not last forever. Christmas comes. Spring follows. God is faithful, even when progress feels slow and hope feels distant. So let’s keep walking together. Keep worshiping. Keep loving. Keep trusting. The story God is writing is not finished yet.

# Elementary Focus

A DEEP DIVE INTO THE SPIRITUAL  
AND PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT OF OUR 2ND GRADERS

**SECOND GRADERS** are active learners who are growing in both independence and understanding. At this age, children learn best when their minds, bodies, and hearts are all engaged. They are curious, energetic, and eager to make sense of the world around them—including their faith.

Physically, second graders still need movement to learn well. Hands-on activities, games, crafts, and opportunities to move help them stay focused and engaged. Writing, drawing, building, and acting out stories strengthen fine and gross motor skills while also helping lessons “stick.” Even short moments of movement during class can make a big difference in how well they absorb information.

Spiritually, second graders are beginning to understand God’s stories in more concrete ways. They enjoy learning Bible stories, asking questions, and connecting faith to their everyday lives. Prayer becomes more meaningful as they learn to express their own thoughts and feelings to God. They also learn a great deal by example—watching trusted adults live out kindness, forgiveness, and gratitude.

For second graders, spiritual growth is closely tied to relationships and experience. When church is a place where they feel valued, encouraged, and safe to ask questions, children grow in both faith and confidence. Through active learning, caring guidance, and loving community, second graders continue building a strong foundation for a lifelong relationship with God.

## HOW CAN YOU PRAY FOR THIS CLASS?

# Preschool Focus

A DEEP DIVE INTO THE SPIRITUAL  
AND PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT OF OUR TWO YEAR OLDS



**TWO YEAR OLDS** are busy learners—absorbing the world through their bodies, senses, and relationships. At this age, learning is not about sitting still or memorizing facts. It happens through movement, repetition, imitation, and loving connection.

Physically, two-year-olds learn by doing. Climbing, stacking, dancing, clapping, and exploring help them understand how their bodies work and how the world responds to their actions. Simple routines such as washing hands, cleaning up toys, or walking to class build coordination, confidence, and independence. Movement is not a distraction for toddlers; it is their primary way of learning.

Spiritually, two-year-olds learn through love, safety, and example. They may not understand Bible stories in detail, but they feel God's presence through gentle voices, kind hands, and familiar routines. Simple prayers, songs, and repeated phrases like "God loves you" help lay a foundation of faith. When caregivers show patience, joy, and compassion, toddlers begin to experience what God's love looks like in everyday life.

For two-year-olds, spiritual and physical learning are closely connected. Feeling safe enough to explore, move, and try new things grows from trusting relationships.

When adults kneel to their level, offer comfort, and celebrate small discoveries, children learn that church is a place where they are known, loved, and welcomed—just as they are.

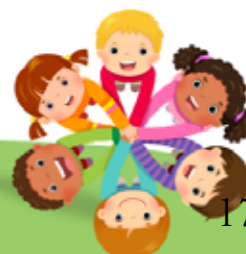

### **Bio:**

Nathan and Abigail are involved in international student ministry at Oxford University and mentor and coach Chinese church planters and pastors in mainland China. After serving as missionaries in China for 12 years, they were forced to leave China and relocated to England to continue to work with Chinese students and immigrants there. They maintain close ties with ministry partners within the underground Baptist church network in China and Nathan travels to Asia to meet with these pastors and church planters four times a year. Their greatest desire is to see the name of Jesus Christ exalted through healthy churches being established among the unreached peoples and places of the world.
