



The KINGS ACADEMY Study Group is a peer-led men's bible study. Because this group is *peer-led* it encourages group discussion and critical thinking. As a result, learning comes through *discovery* rather than through instruction (where the teacher provides all the answers).

The KINGS ACADEMY Study Group takes a deep dive into the reigns of the kings of Israel. The goal is to glean leadership principles that could help in leading in the home, workplace and at church.

The KINGS ACADEMY Study Group meets once a month via zoom (or some other platform of the groups choosing). Each group is given a reading assignment each month along with a set of discussion questions. Group members are asked to engage with the assignment throughout the month, reading and re-reading the material to prompt deeper insight into the text. Each month when the group meets, discussions will take place in a roundtable format where each student is given an opportunity to share insights and/or questions they have gleaned from study. Each lesson will end with a summary (key takeaways) from the lesson.

The KINGS ACADEMY is built on the belief that God's word "furnishes" and equips men to operate in the service and office God has assigned them to. Also, it's designed with the belief that true learning takes place when God's people engage with His word (by reading and speaking it).
