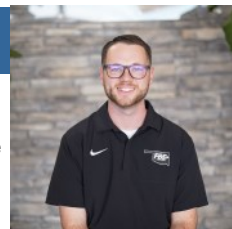

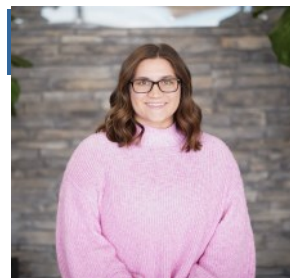

Some of you have been asking about Legacy of Faith. If you remember, we started the program the first of April, so we have not had a whole year yet. But as of Dec 31, we have had \$128,460 given. That is what I thought we might raise totally, but you have bought in & we are doing so much better. Our long range goal is to buy some catastrophic insurance with an approximate \$5000 deductible that would cover tornados. Then put back the \$1 million for less costly claims. We hope the large deductible would lower the premiums a lot. We will have to wait one more year to see. All our claims will be wiped out in one more year. So thank you for your faithfulness. Right now we have over \$550,000 in our Building account. We also still have our emergency account. With one more year of the Legacy of Faith program, we can beat our million dollars. PRAISE THE LORD!

I just want to say I'm excited to have Steve McKee on as a staff member. He already is showing how valuable he is. God knows what he was doing in having us wait until Steve was ready. I think God has some great things ahead of FBE this year.

We still have a few places on our Ark trip if you want to go. Let me know quickly!

Our Coffee Corner mission will be the PRC. Every penny over our costs will be given to them.
