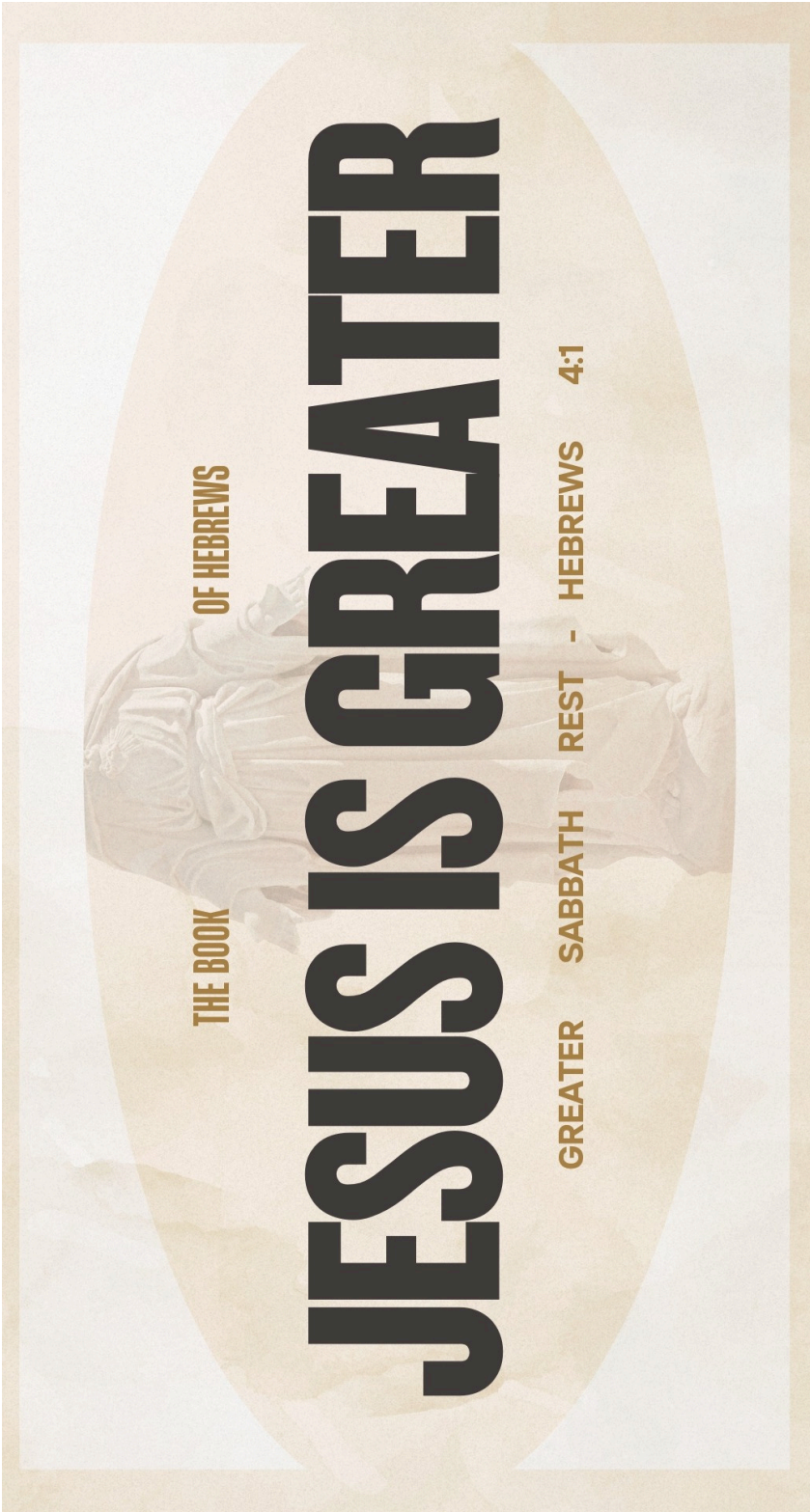

Message from the Elders:

Walking with God, we often see things differently than others around us.

Next Sunday millions will gather with friends and family to witness the largest U.S. sporting event of the year. GO HAWKS! When the teams take the field, it will be to compete before more than 100 million witnesses who will each be cheering for their own team to win. In a way, the kingdom of heaven is like this.

We too are involved in a competition before what the Bible refers to as “a great cloud of witnesses.” But ours is not a game; the Bible likens it to a race. And the spectators are not just the living, but also those who have gone before us, the angels, and the host of heaven. They are all watching to see how we run our race; how firmly we hold to the teachings and character of Jesus. Just like the Superbowl, each witness has their own team. The angels, your loved ones, and all of God’s heroes from past generations are watching and rooting for you. But our adversary, the Devil and his followers, want you to fail in order to hurt God.

You can be sure next Sunday, the players will be tuned in to those fans who are rooting for them. 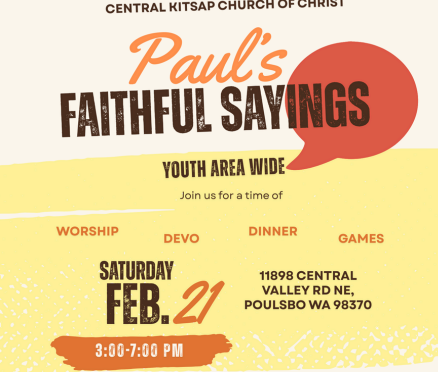

MISSION CORNER:



Many of you know that the Pusey family recently visited Vietnam to spend time with Katina, an LST (Let's Start Talking) “reader”. Katina was a Buddhist, converted to Christianity, and works as a full time missionary at this time.

During our stay we worked with her in her capacity as a missionary with CCC (Campus Crusade for Christ- Vietnam’s version of Cru). While visiting, we attended several gatherings where we were able to use our ability to speak native English as a tool for evangelism. This form of outreach is the foundational way they attract college age individuals to fellowship groups where they are exposed to deep friendships and the Gospel message.

CCC sponsors and trains young adults to evangelize by offering them support (including a home) while attending college. Katina was saved and became an evangelist in this way. She organized a lunch date with Daniel and his wife, Sue (leaders of CCC) where we learned of two important needs they have for the ministry.

First, financial support for the 15 houses they run this ministry through. **Secondly**, prayer for the goal they have of reaching 1 million people and 10,000 multiplying disciples. Countless Christians have set their alarms for 20:33 (8:30) every night and stop to pray for this request as they are petitioning the Lord to reach this goal by the year 2033.
