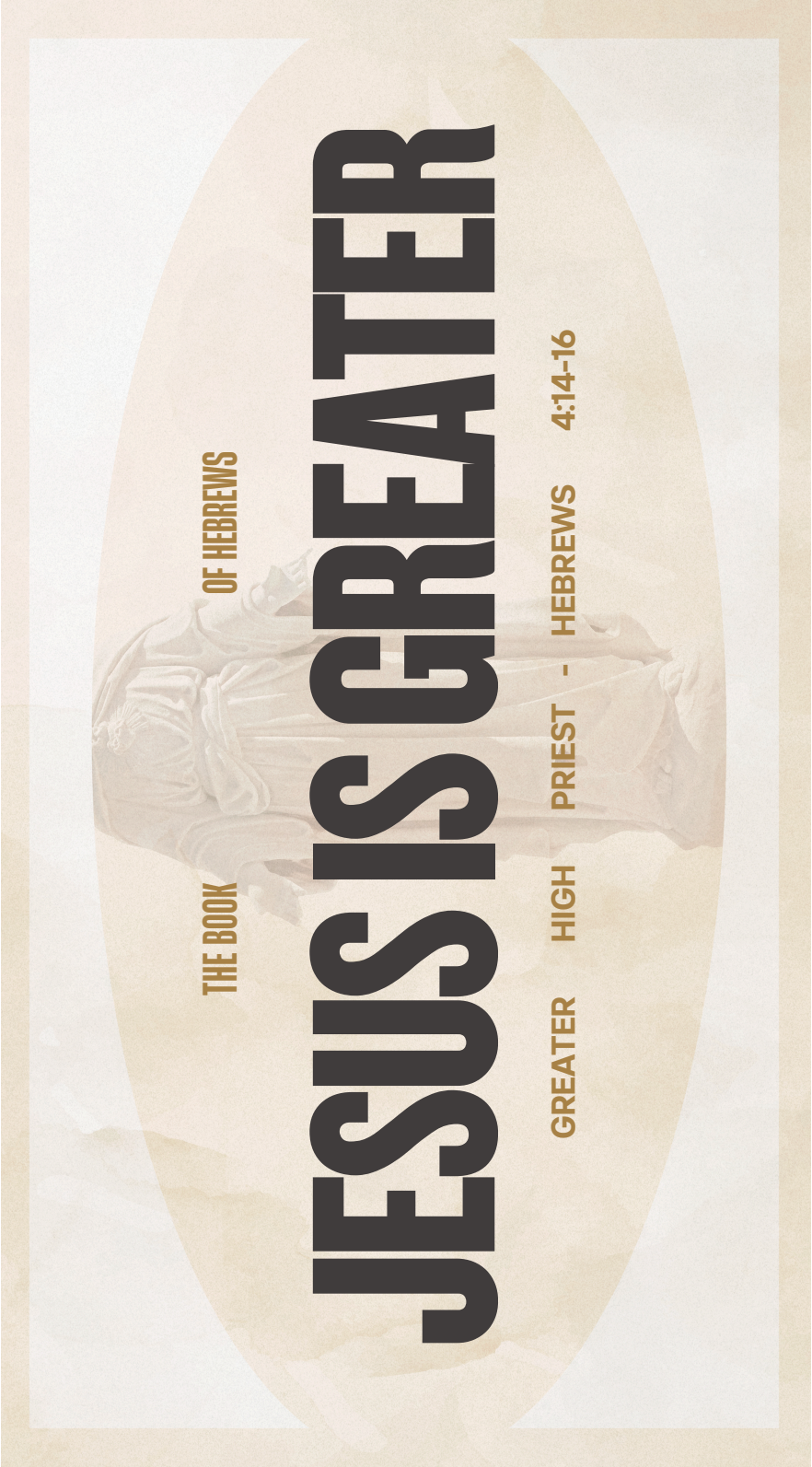

MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

In some ways, walking with the LORD is like a game of musical chairs. During the game, while the music is playing, the participants can run around the circle however they choose. Some may keep their circle tight, knowing the goal is to get into an empty chair when the music stops. Others may choose to lighten up and enjoy the opportunity to run and dance more freely. It doesn't really matter where the players are while the music is playing. But when the music stops, only those who are where they need to be can stay in the game.

In a similar way, Jesus told the thief on the cross that "Today you will be with me in paradise." (Luke 23:43). This man had presumably wasted his life and had been condemned for real crimes. But in the last hour of his life, he came to Jesus. If anyone could be "too late," it would be him - yet Jesus welcomed him instantly.

The bad news is that we all "lighten up" from time to time and fail to follow God's commands. We choose to go our own way and often live to regret the decision.

The good news is that, it really doesn't matter where you are while the music is playing or where you've been. But where will you be when the music stops? Our prayer for you, no matter where you've been, is that when the music of your life stops you'll be just where you need to be - in Jesus!
