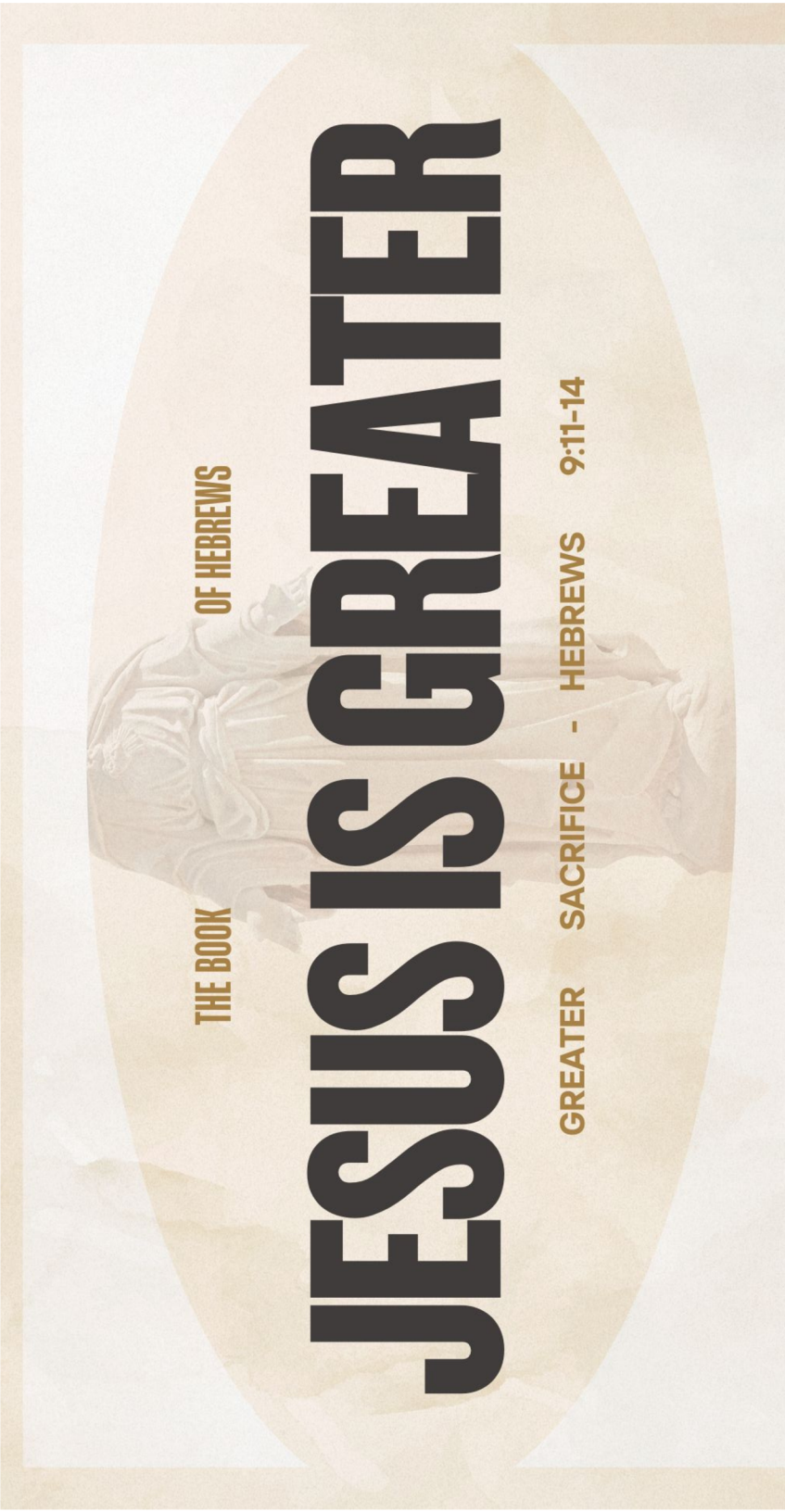

MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

Walking with God is about forgiving and being forgiven.

Years ago, when my father was losing his memory to Alzheimer's, I used to read passages of scripture to him. One day we were reading through the book of Matthew and, as I read the Lord's prayer, he stopped me and asked me to read "that last part" (Mt 6:14-15) again. And then again. He became very contemplative and finally said, "I need to begin forgiving people PDQ". I asked him what "PDQ" meant and he replied, "pretty darn quick". The message is unmistakable - even to one with diminished capacity.

Do you have estrangement in your family? Or with a co-worker or friend? Or a fellow believer in Christ? Unlike fine wine, estrangement does not improve with age; it gets worse. Today would be a great day to begin the road toward reconciliation. And that road begins with forgiveness - PDQ.

"For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins." (Mt 6:14-15)
