

A MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS:

Walking with God has a lot to do with how we speak.

During WWII the German battleship, Bismark, was launched. It was one of the largest and most formidable battleships ever built and was made to dominate the North Atlantic. The British realized the damage it could do and sent two battleships to engage it on May 24, 1941. Almost immediately, Bismark sank the HMS Hood, the pride of the Royal Navy. After that, the second British Battleship, HMS Prince of Wales, wisely stayed out of range of Bismark's guns but simply followed it, reporting on its position.

Bismark was the fastest battleship ever built. It's armor was incredibly advanced and nearly impenetrable. It's fire control accuracy was ahead of it's time – allowing it to sink HMS Hood only minutes into the battle. The ship was nearly impregnable. But on May 26, 1941, British torpedo planes scored a hit on it's one weak spot – its rudder - making it un-maneuverable. The next day, the Royal Navy moved in while the mighty Bismark circled helplessly and was finally sunk.

The Bible likens our tongue to a ship's rudder. Just as a small rudder sets the course of a great ship, so our tongue sets our course in life. When uncontrolled, the tongue can function as "a restless evil, full of deadly poison" (Jas 3:8). Jesus even said that our words are a direct reflection of what is in our hearts (Mt 12:33-37). That is why we are encouraged to consider our words carefully. As for me, I've never regretted holding my tongue when I was angry. But I've often regretted the things I've said in anger. How about you?

"Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry..." (Jas 1:19).
