Day 1: God's Abundant Grace

Reading: John 2:1-11

Devotional:

The miracle at Cana reveals Jesus' first public display of His divine power and glory. More than just turning water into wine, this miracle demonstrates God's abundant grace. When we feel our resources have run dry, Jesus meets our insufficiency with His abundance.

Reflect on areas in your life where you feel depleted or insufficient. How might Jesus be inviting you to trust Him to provide abundantly beyond what you can imagine? Remember, with God, our empty jars can become vessels of overflowing joy and provision.

Prayer: Lord, help me trust in Your abundant grace, especially in areas where I feel lacking. Transform my insufficiency into a testimony of Your glory.

Day 2: Faith That Moves Mountains

Reading: Matthew 17:14-20

Devotional:

Jesus teaches that faith as small as a mustard seed can move mountains. This echoes Mary's faith at the wedding in Cana when she told the servants, "Do whatever He tells you." Her faith set the stage for Jesus to reveal His glory.

Consider a challenging situation in your life. How might you exercise mustard seed faith today? Remember, it's not the size of your faith that matters, but the size of the God in whom you place your faith.

Prayer: Father, increase my faith. Help me to trust You even when circumstances seem impossible, knowing that with You, all things are possible.





Day 3: From Ordinary to Extraordinary

Reading: 1 Corinthians 1:26-31

Devotional:

God delights in using the ordinary to display His extraordinary power. Just as Jesus transformed ordinary water into the finest wine, He desires to transform our lives from the mundane to the miraculous.

Reflect on how God might be calling you to offer your "ordinary" to Him today. What talents, resources, or opportunities – however small they may seem – can you surrender for His use?

Prayer: Lord, take my ordinary life and make it extraordinary for Your glory. Help me see the potential You see in me.

Day 4: God's Glory in Our Weakness

Reading: 2 Corinthians 12:7-10

Devotional:

Paul learned that God's power is made perfect in weakness. Similarly, the wedding at Cana shows how Jesus reveals His glory most clearly in moments of human inadequacy.

What weaknesses or struggles are you facing? Instead of being discouraged by them, how might you invite God to display His strength through these very areas?

Prayer: Heavenly Father, I surrender my weaknesses to You. May Your power shine brightly through my limitations, bringing glory to Your name.





Day 5: Experiencing God's Presence

Reading: Psalm 16:5-11

Devotional:

The Psalmist rejoices in the Lord's presence, finding in Him fullness of joy. Jesus' presence at the wedding in Cana brought not just provision, but joy and celebration.

How aware are you of God's presence in your daily life? Take time today to intentionally acknowledge His presence in both the extraordinary and ordinary moments.

Prayer: Jesus, open my eyes to recognize Your presence with me always. May I experience the fullness of joy found only in You.
