This week is North Point Women's Sunday, when we will celebrate as a church family the many contributions of the women in our church. And the Scripture passages we'll look at together feature two women—sisters—who were beloved to Jesus. His interactions with them in the gospels not only give us insight into their beautiful friendship, but encourage us in our own relationship with him (and each other) as we walk together in "The Way." With so many things in our lives that frustrate, distract, worry, and grieve us, what is the "one thing" that puts it all in perspective? Men and women, young and old: Jesus has something for you in this family story.

Here are some questions to consider as you go into this week:

Have you paused to consider that Jesus sees you as he saw Martha and Mary: that he loves you, and knows and cherishes your unique gifts and ability to serve him and others? What difference does that knowledge make as you go into this week?

What are the "many things" worrying and distracting you right now? Like Martha, are you feeling worn out, unappreciated, and frustrated? Will you trust him to understand, and to redirect your perspective to him and his care for you?

Especially as we look forward to this season of Lent, what are some practical ways we can build into our own lives times of "sitting at the Lord's feet, listening to what he says"?

Jesus says also to us: "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; and whoever lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this?" Will you accept that gift of life that is eternal and starts now, in your circumstances today?
