We have been exploring what it means to follow Jesus as people of the "The Way". To truly understand what it means to live and act in the Jesus "Way", we must be drawn to Jesus' teachings. Famed martyr and German theologian Dietrich Bonhoeffer wrote his doctoral dissertation on "The Sermon on the Mount" precisely because it is the longest and highest ethical teaching the gospel writers record for us. Today we will read, study, and reflect on the first section of this 'sermon' (Matthew 5:1-12).

We will learn what the word "blessed" means as Jesus uses this word multiple times. In doing so we will discover that Jesus is giving us 'sign-posts' to look for and recognize as people of the Way. Please use the following reflection questions to spend time with God, exalt Christ, and seek the Holy Spirit as a person striving to practice the "Way".

1. By defining the word blessed as "you are on the right path when....", how does it change your reading of the Beatitudes?
2. Pastor Rob spoke about what each of the Beatitudes has in common. What is that one thing and can you name places in your life (now or in the past) where you are experiencing this?
3. How can you better live into the Beatitudes? How do we help others in community live into the Beatitudes?
