Day 1

Exodus 6:2-9

1. In verse 5, what prompted the Lord to send Moses and Aaron to Egypt?
2. In verses 6-8, what is the Lord's purpose in sending Moses and Aaron to Egypt?
3. In verse 9, how do the people respond to Moses' message from the Lord?

Exodus 7:14-25

The First Plague: Waters Become Blood

4. Where does the Lord tell Moses to meet Pharaoh in the morning? What is the significance of this location?
5. In verse 16, what message does the Lord ask Moses to give to Pharaoh? How would this message affect Pharaoh if he had complied?
6. What is the first sign that the Lord gives Pharaoh to show him that He is Lord?
7. How does turning the river into blood affect the Egyptians?
8. In verse 22, why does Pharaoh's heart harden?
9. In verse 24, how do the Egyptians find water to drink?
10. In verse 25, how long does the first plague last?

Day 2

Exodus 8:1-15

The Second Plague: Frogs

1. What message does the Lord repeat in verse 1?
2. List all areas the frogs would in the Egyptians' homes.
3. What is one word you would use to describe the plague of frogs?
4. How does Pharaoh's request in verse 8 fall short of the Lord's request in verse 1?
5. Even though the Lord heeded Moses' request to stop the plague of frogs, there were still consequences. What was the consequence of the plague of frogs to the Egyptians in verse 14? How is this similar to the consequence of sin in our lives?
6. Why did Pharaoh harden his heart in verse 14?

Exodus 8:16-19

The Third Plague: Lice

7. What is affected by the third plague?
8. How is this plague different for the magicians than the first two?
9. How does Pharaoh respond to this change?
10. How do we respond sometimes when the Lord warns us about sin in our lives?

Day 3

Exodus 8:20-32

The Fourth Plague: Flies

1. How is verse 8:20 similar to verses 7:15-16? What does this tell you about Pharaoh?
2. How does the fourth plague affect the Egyptians?
3. Why does the Lord set apart the land of Goshen?
4. In verse 25, how does Pharaoh's command fall short of the Lord's request?
5. In verse 28, how would you describe Pharaoh's heart?

Exodus 9:1-7

The Fifth Plague: Livestock Diseased

6. In verse 3, what does the fifth plague affect?
7. How would this plague affect Egyptian society?
8. In verses 1-7, how did the Lord separate the Egyptians from the Israelites?

The Sixth Plague: Boils

9. What does the sixth plague affect?

10. Why couldn't the magicians stand before Moses?

11. What does this tell you about the magicians?

12. How is verse 12 different from all the other times that Pharaoh hardened his heart?

Day 4

Exodus 9:13-35

The Seventh Plague: Hail

1. From verse 14, how is the seventh plague intended to affect Pharaoh?
2. From verse 16-17, why is the Lord sending the seventh plague?
3. From verses 19-21, the Lord shows mercy by warning the Egyptians. How do some of Pharaoh's servants respond to this warning?
4. In verse 22-26, we see an escalation of how the plagues affect the land of Egypt. What does the seventh do?
5. How does the Lord protect His people?
6. In verses 27-28, we see signs of repentance in Pharaoh? What are some indications that he was repentant?
7. From verse 34, what do we learn about Pharaoh?
8. Read 2 Corinthians 7:9-11. How would you characterize Pharaoh's repentance in verses 27-28?
9. What does the bible say about a double-minded man in James 1:5-8?

Day 5

Exodus 10:1-20

The Eighth Plague: Locusts

1. In verse 2, the Lord adds a purpose for the plagues. What does he tell Moses about the purpose of the signs of the plagues?
2. What is the eighth plague? What is it designed to do?
3. According to Exodus 9:31-32, what was left from the seventh plague?
4. What does verse 7 tell you about the servants' attitude toward the Lord?
5. In verse 9, how has Moses' request change from his original request?
6. In verse 10, what does Pharaoh agree to do?
7. In verses 12-15, what is the result of the eighth plague?
8. How is verse 17 in this chapter different from verse 27 in chapter 9?

Day 6

Exodus 10:21-29

The Ninth Plague: Darkness

1. How is the plague of darkness different from regular darkness?
2. How long did the ninth plague last?
3. What does Moses request this time that Pharaoh refuses? Why does Pharaoh refuse to let the Israelites take this with them?
4. In verse 28, what is ironic about the statement that Pharaoh declares to Moses?

Exodus 11:1-10

5. What does the Lord tell Moses for the people to ask of their neighbors?
6. What does the Lord tell Moses the final plague will be?
7. What is the Lord's purpose in hardening Pharaoh's heart this last time?
