Bible Story: Jesus Demonstrates His Power *Mark 4:35-41*

Big Idea: Jesus is God's Son

Focus: Jesus is God's Son and He has power over everything.

Memory Verse: "But these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God. If you believe this, you will have life because you belong to him." *John 20:31 (NIV)*

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on *Mark 3:35-41*, *1 Chronicles 29:11*; *Matthew 19:26*; *Psalm 150:1-2*; *Exodus 15:1*.

Jesus was asleep in a boat with His disciples when a terrible storm struck. The disciples woke Him, fearing for their lives. Jesus rebuked their lack of faith, calmed the storm, and left them amazed. Jesus did many miracles to prove that He was the Son of God.

He Question: How is Jesus so powerful?

Jesus showed that He is God and has God's power. He is omnipotent, and His power has no limits!

We Question: Is Jesus' power scary?

Jesus is 100 percent good and loves us so much. We can respond with awe and wonder at His amazing power.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



Play a game of rock, paper, scissors at bedtime. Explain that in this game the rock has power over the scissors, the scissors has power over the paper, and the paper has power over the rock. Play several times. Explain that in this game each item had more power than another item. Ask them if anything or anyone has more power than Jesus. The answer is no. Talk about some of the miracles Jesus did. Jesus is God's Son and He has power over everything. And we can know that He loves us and is for us. Pray, and thank Jesus for His love and power.
