TODAY: FEBRUARY 14-15

Bible Story: The Transfiguration *Mark 9:2-13; Luke 9:28-36*

Big Idea: Jesus is Lord of All

Focus: Jesus is Lord of All and He reveals God's glory

Memory Verse: "When the name of Jesus is spoken, everyone will kneel down to worship Him." *Philippians 2:10 (NirV)*

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on **John 1:14; Hebrews 1:3; Colossians 1:15; 1 John 4:15**

Jesus took James, John and Peter up on a mountain. While Jesus was praying, the appearance of His face was altered, and His clothing began to shine. Moses and Elijah appeared and spoke with Jesus about what was to come. The disciples were sleeping but awoke when they saw Jesus in His glory. Peter offered to make tents for each of them. The voice of God came down and declared Jesus was His Son.

He Question: What is God's glory?

God's glory is His magnificence on display. By showing God's glory, Jesus showed He is fully God.

We Question: How can we respond to who Jesus is?

We can listen to Jesus and believe He is the Son of God. We can trust in Jesus as our Lord and Savior.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.

Bed Time



Ask your child what they think it would have been like to have been on the mountain that day with Jesus, Peter, James, and John. What would you have thought or done? Would you have been scared like Peter? Jesus' glory was on display. It clearly showed the disciples that He was fully God. One day everyone who trusts in Jesus will get to see the glory of God face to face. Trust Him with your life and have faith in Him.

DAY 1

READ *Philippians 2:10*

You have been working to memorize this verse for the month of February. Take some time to practice it now by building! Go grab blocks or Legos and get to work.

Start with one base block. Then, for each word of the verse, stack a new block on top. Keep stacking until it is so tall that it falls down. Once it falls, restart and see how many times you can say the verse before the tower falls!

How many times were you able to say the verse? (It should take 15 blocks to say the whole verse and where it's found!) Write your number on the line.

PRACTICE this memory verse as a reminder that Jesus is Lord of all.

DAY 2

READ *John 1:14*

This verse talks about how the Word became a human being. Who do you think that could be? It says "He came from the Father, and his Word was full of grace and truth."

READ Mark 9:2-13

With the help of a parent, answer the questions about the story.
