Bible Story: The Feeding of 5,000 *John 6:1-15*

Big Idea: Jesus is Lord of All

Focus: Jesus is Lord of all and He provides for us

Memory Verse: "When the name of Jesus is spoken, everyone will kneel down to worship Him. Everyone's mouth will say that Jesus Christ is Lord. And God the Father will receive the glory." *Philippians 2:10-11 NIV*

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on **Psalm 24:1; Deuteronomy 10:14; Luke 1:37; Philippians 4:19**

A large crowd followed Jesus. Jesus asked Philip where they could buy food for the crowd. Andrew mentioned a boy with five loaves and two fish. Jesus had the people sit, blessed the food and distributed it. Everyone ate their fill, and twelve baskets of leftovers were collected. Because of this amazing miracle, the crowd recognized Jesus as the prophet they had been waiting for.

He Question: How is Jesus able to provide?

Jesus is God and He is Lord over all things. Nothing is impossible for Him and everything belongs to Him.

We Question: What can Jesus provide?

Everything we have is a gift from Jesus. He knows our needs. We can trust He is able to provide according to His perfect will.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



As you sit down to eat your dinner, look at all the food on the table. Guess how many people your food would feed. Discuss how Jesus fed 5,000 hungry people with just enough food for one person. Jesus did a miracle to care and provide for their needs. Before you eat, pray and thank Jesus for being Lord of all and providing for you.

READ *Philippians 2:10-11*

This week in our Bible story, Jesus showed He was Lord of All by feeding over 5,000 people with a boy's small lunch. Only God could do that.

Read the Bible story and fill in the crossword puzzle


Across
