TODAY: FEBRUARY 21-22

Bible Story: The Feeding of 5,000 *John 6:1-15*

Big Idea: Jesus is Lord of All

Focus: Jesus is Lord of all and He provides for us

Memory Verse: "When the name of Jesus is spoken, everyone will kneel down to worship Him." *Philippians 2:10 (NirV)*

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on **Psalm 24:1; Deuteronomy 10:14; Luke 1:37; Philippians 4:19**

A large crowd followed Jesus. Jesus asked Philip where they could buy food for the crowd. Andrew mentioned a boy with five loaves and two fish. Jesus had the people sit, blessed the food and distributed it. Everyone ate their fill, and twelve baskets of leftovers were collected. Because of this amazing miracle, the crowd recognized Jesus as the prophet they had been waiting for.

He Question: How is Jesus able to provide?

Jesus is God and He is Lord over all things. Nothing is impossible for Him and everything belongs to Him.

We Question: What can Jesus provide?

Everything we have is a gift from Jesus. He knows our needs. We can trust He is able to provide according to His perfect will.

Me Question: How is God inviting me to respond?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.

Drive Time



While you are driving, ask your child if there is something they need to ask Jesus to help them with. Maybe it's a good trustworthy friend, to help them not be afraid of something, or to have the courage to do the right thing. After they share, pray and ask the Lord to help provide for that need. God will always provide. There might be needs that seem impossible, but He is Lord of all and there is nothing that's impossible for Him. You just need to trust that He will provide it.



DAY 1

READ *Philippians 2:10*

This week we learned that Jesus provides for us! The crowd of 5,000 needed food to eat. A basket of 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish became more than enough to feed everyone. Let's be a little silly as you practice your verse. For the first word, act like a fish swimming, then for the second word pretend you are a piece of toast popping out of the toaster. Continue alternating these actions to the words in the verse. Now put it all together and practice saying the verse all the way through a few times.

DAY 2

READ *Psalm 24:1, Deuteronomy 10:14*

These verses share how EVERYTHING belongs to God. He is not Lord over some things but over ALL things. Your house, clothing, and food are all gifts from God. But even your friends, helping you not to be afraid, and having wisdom to make decisions are gifts. There is nothing that is impossible for Him. He knows all the things that you need. You just have to trust that He will provide for you in His perfect plan.

READ John 6:1-15
