## Monday

**READ:** Colossians 1:1–2; Romans 8:1

**REFLECT:** Paul begins by reminding the Colossians who they are — saints, faithful brothers and sisters, and most importantly, “in Christ.” To be “in Christ” means your position before God has changed permanently. You are no longer defined by failure, shame, or performance, but by union with Christ.

**RESPOND:** Where do you tend to find your identity? In performance, reputation, success? Take some time to thank God specifically that you are “in Christ.”

## Tuesday

**READ:** Colossians 1:3–6; John 15:5

**REFLECT:** Paul celebrates the Colossians’ faith, love, and hope because the gospel was bearing fruit among them. The gospel is a living power that produces visible change. Faith anchors you in Christ, love expresses itself toward others, and hope fuels perseverance. The same gospel that saved you continues to grow you from the inside out.

**RESPOND:** Who has benefited recently from the fruit of Christ in you? Ask God to help you abide in him rather than striving in your own strength.

## Wednesday

**READ:** Colossians 1:9; James 1:5

**REFLECT:** Paul does not pray for easier circumstances; he prays for deeper spiritual capacity. He asks that believers be filled with the knowledge of God’s will through spiritual wisdom and understanding. God shapes our thinking so he can shape our living.

**RESPOND:** Pray Colossians 1:9 over yourself and your family today. Ask him to help you see your current situation from his perspective.

## Thursday

**READ:** Colossians 1:10–12; Ephesians 4:1

**REFLECT:** A worthy walk flows from gospel knowledge. Paul describes it in four ways: bearing fruit, growing in knowledge of God, enduring hardship, and giving thanks. Notice how it progresses — obedience deepens intimacy, and endurance produces gratitude. God’s power strengthens us not to escape difficulty but to remain faithful within it.

**RESPOND:** Where are you tempted to quit right now? Ask God for endurance. Write down three reasons you can give thanks today, regardless of circumstances.

## Friday

**READ:** Colossians 1:13–14; 2 Corinthians 5:17

**REFLECT:** Paul describes salvation as a rescue and transfer. You have been delivered from the domain of darkness and relocated into the kingdom of God’s Son. This is not self-improvement; it is a complete change of realm, ruler, and identity. God has already done it. Redemption and forgiveness are secured in Christ, not sustained by your effort.

**RESPOND:** Do you live as if you are still under the old kingdom’s authority? What “old address” habits still try to show up at your door?
