Monday

READ: Colossians 1:15; John 14:9

REFLECT: Jesus is not a shadow or reflection but the full expression of God the Father. Think about how you naturally picture God. Is he distant, harsh, patient, compassionate? Jesus corrects distorted images of God by revealing to us exactly what God the Father is like. His mercy toward sinners and the broken reveals God's true heart.

RESPOND: Ask God to reshape any false perceptions you may carry. Ask him to help you see him clearly so you can trust him fully.

Tuesday

READ: Colossians 1:16–17; Hebrews 1:3

REFLECT: Every breath, moment, and unseen detail is upheld by Christ's power. It's easy to believe God is powerful in the universe but absent in our personal struggles. However, God's Word proclaims that Christ actively sustains all things including you. If he holds galaxies together, what does that mean for your fears and anxieties?

RESPOND: Name one unstable area in your life. Speak aloud: "Jesus, you are holding this together." Say this throughout the day as an act of worship to him.

Wednesday

READ: Colossians 1:18; Matthew 28:18

REFLECT: The resurrection confirms Christ's authority over death, fear, and every power. He is not just Savior but also reigning King. Think about what occupies first place in your thoughts. Whatever dominates your mind often shapes your trust. The good news is that Christ's authority extends over every circumstance you face.

RESPOND: What would shift in your heart if you placed Christ at the center? Surrender your concerns to Christ's authority. Praise him that nothing and no one outranks him.

Thursday

READ: Colossians 1:21–22; 2 Corinthians 5:18–19

REFLECT: Through the cross of Christ, we are reconciled by God. Unfortunately, rather than living as someone who is reconciled to him, we live as someone trying to earn acceptance. Shame often lingers even after forgiveness is offered and received. The cross declares that hostility has ended and peace has begun.

RESPOND: Confess to God any guilt, shame, or self-condemnation. Thank Christ for making peace through his cross. Live today as someone who is fully accepted by God.

Friday

READ: Colossians 1:23; Hebrews 12:2

REFLECT: Persevering requires fixing our eyes on Jesus. Stability grows from sustained focus on who he is. Faith rarely collapses overnight. Rather, it erodes over time. Staying grounded means continually returning to Christ's supremacy.

RESPOND: Thank God for holding you steady in the midst of your discouragement and anxiety. Say to yourself aloud: "Because Christ is supreme, I will stand firm."
