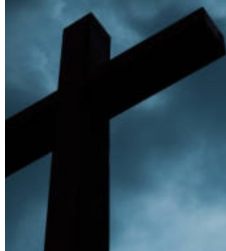

That's our mission at Troy Methodist Church, and this April is your perfect opportunity to live it out! Not only can you look forward to an amazing month of worship, but you can also look forward to sharing it with others. If TMC is your church home, please consider participating in our mission in one or more of the seven following ways in April:

1. **Invite** – This is by far the best way to live out our mission! Invite a friend to experience the hope of the resurrection and the joy of new life in Christ. Grab a few invite cards at worship and share them with your family, friends, coworkers and neighbors. Keep one on you at all times so you're ready to invite whenever God opens a door. And don't forget to invite people to any of the other exciting services or events this April!
2. **Social media** – Get your picture taken at worship on Palm Sunday, April 13, and post it to Facebook or Instagram inviting your friends to Easter worship services. We also plan to have a profile frame available on Facebook for you to add to your profile picture temporarily. Let's get the word out about the new life Jesus offers and our worship opportunities this Easter.
3. **Come early, park and walk** – We expect our parking lots to be full and maybe a tad chaotic on Easter Sunday. If you are able, please consider coming early and parking as far away as you can (softball fields even!). Leaving the close spots open for guests and those who cannot walk long distances is a great form of hospitality. And coming early will help relieve congestion in the parking lot.
4. **Join us for the sunrise service** – Consider coming early for our 7:00 a.m. Sunrise service in the Sanctuary! It will not only be an awesome service, but coming early will create more space for guests during our normal service times. (And you can easily stick around for breakfast at 7:45 a.m.!)
5. **Sit up front** – We expect our sanctuary to be full for Easter, so consider sitting closer to the front or scootching into the center of your row to allow more space on the aisles and in the back for guests or late-comers.
6. **Serve** – In order to provide radical hospitality for everyone, we are calling you out of the stands and onto the field! We anticipate needing extra hands to usher, greet, serve in children's ministry and as parking attendants. If you are willing to serve during one or more of the worship services, please contact bonnie@troymc.org.
7. **Participate in worship** – I am looking for around 50 people who have experienced the love of Jesus to play a special (and easy) role in our Easter worship services. You won't have to say anything, but it will be a powerful way to proclaim God's goodness. Email or call me and I will share more! Anyone middle school age and up could participate.

I can't wait to live out our mission together!

(And I will give a special reward to anyone who lets me know you did so in all 7 of these ways!)

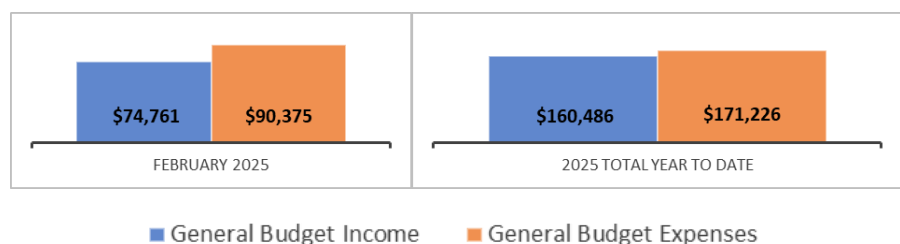

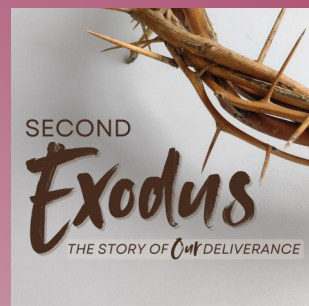

Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day." Spend just a few moments daily in pursuit of being renewed by God. UPWARD 2025 MISSION PROJECT

This year, our Upward participants, coaches, and families participated in their annual Upward Paper Drive and extended the invitation to our church family to be a part of the fun! Mission projects are such a great opportunity for everyone involved to remember the importance of both service and generosity; and boy, were you all generous!

This year the group collected 1,251 rolls of toilet paper, 226 rolls of paper towels, and 84 boxes of Kleenex, along with a handful of packages of napkins, paper plates and Clorox wipes! Because of the generosity of everyone involved we have helped stock the shelves of five area pantries! Thank you to everyone who chose to give generously! What a joy it is to serve our communities together and share the love of Christ in such a tangible way!

Our Care Ministry is excited to announce a new ministry area under our umbrella. We're calling this new area **Caring Hearts Ministry** — it's a special outreach dedicated to ensuring that every person homebound or in a facility receives a personal phone call and visit each month. We plan to kick off this new ministry on April 1, 2025. We want each person to feel they are a cherished part of God's family, and no one should feel forgotten or alone.

The ministry's goal is to provide emotional support, companionship, and encouragement to elderly individuals who may feel isolated or overlooked. The mission and purpose is to love and care for them through personal interactions to ensure seniors feel valued and remembered, offer prayer, encouragement, and meaningful conversation, and to identify needs and provide help when possible.

This ministry has two components: 1.) Gold Members – Church members 90+ and 2.) Homebound – members who live in their home, but physically unable to get out and those who live in a facility.

We are putting together teams of volunteers (in teams of 2), and each team will be assigned to regularly call and visit those seniors in our congregation who are shut-in or in a facility. Visits include friendly conversation, prayer, and checking on any specific needs. Calls serve as a reminder that they are loved and provide encouragement and a listening ear.

This initiative ensures those members receive regular care and stay connected to their church community, reinforcing the love and presence of God in their lives.

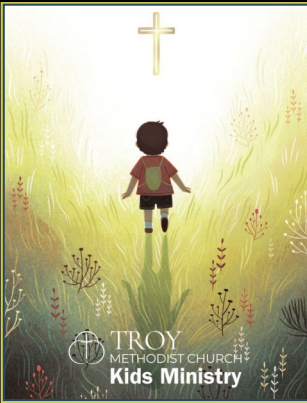
