A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR ANDY



NO LONGER “TRANSITIONAL” – THE GMC GENERAL CONFERENCE

Although I’ve delayed writing this article as long as possible, the convening General Conference of the Global Methodist Church is not yet finished. Over 300 delegates from around the world, including Troy Methodist Church member, Tom Finley, gathered for the opening session of this long-awaited gathering on Friday, September 20, 2024. Before the opening session of worship even began, many delegates were overcome by emotion and spontaneous singing could be heard from the conference lobby.

“Over the past few years, we all sensed we were building a truly Global Methodist Church,” said Simon Mafunda, the Global Methodist Church’s Africa Director. “When we all saw each other face to face and had the opportunity to embrace one another in person, it was a moment of intense joy. Praise and thanksgiving just freely poured out of us!”

This convening conference has moved the Global Methodist Church from a “transitional” phase to being an officially organized denomination with its own approved Book of Doctrine and Discipline. Part of this conference’s work is to amend that organizational document, but as of this writing, that is not yet complete. Legislative committees are perfecting and recommending proposals for such edits which will then be voted on by the full body of delegates in the coming days.

On a personal note, it has brought me so much joy to see many friends and colleagues share about their experiences at this convening General Conference held in Costa Rica. They are spending much time in prayer and worship and calling upon the Holy Spirit to breathe revival into our churches. They are also taking time to work with the Methodist Church of Costa Rica to serve the local community. Although the GMC officially launched in May of 2022, this week’s events in Costa Rica mark the official birth of the GMC. This has been a long-anticipated fulfillment of a vision that many, including our church and me, have prayed and sacrificed time and energy to see become a reality. ***To God be the glory.***

I can’t wait for Tom to return and to get an update from him. When you see him, thank him for his service and let him share his excitement about what God is doing in our broader connection. We are part of a movement of God that is much greater than ourselves!

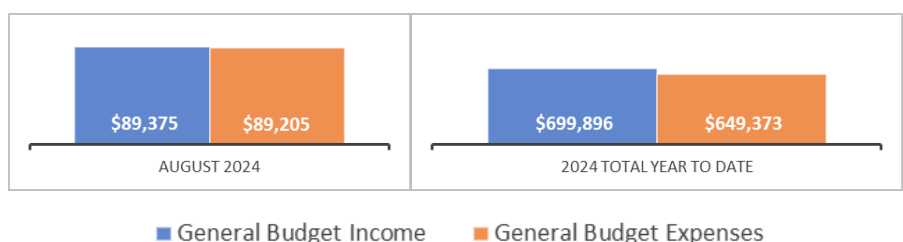

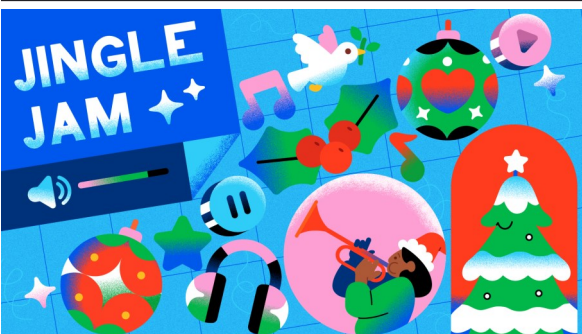
