

Dear Parents,

We hope that your conversations from these lessons have been fruitful over the past several weeks with your teenager. It is a joy to partner with you in helping your student grow as a disciple of Jesus.

This week, our lesson was entitled "Disciples Pray and Praise Together." Praising God together and praying together is part of what binds believers together in Christian community, and helps us grow as disciples of Jesus.

We looked at the following Scripture passages:

- Acts 2:41, 47
- Ephesians 5:15-21
- Acts 1:14

Take a few moments to read these scriptures that show us the impact of praising and praying together with our community of fellow Christ-followers.

NEXT STEPS . . .

During the week, look for ways to encourage your teenager as he or she reflects on what they are learning. Consider using some of these prompts to start conversation.

- When was the last time you really felt the presence of God when worshipping with others?
- Share about a time when you prayed with a group of people and how God moved as a result. Ask your student: "How have you seen God work in the lives of people as you have prayed with others?"
- In our own family, what do you think it would look like if we praised and prayed together in a different way? I'm open to suggestions.
