

Dear Parents,

Hello! This week in Bible study we continued our look at The LIFE, a yearlong study on what it means to live as a follower of Christ. The lesson this week talked about service, and how Jesus came to serve others rather than to be served. We discussed how this is different than what the world perceives those in power, but that service is a part of our Christian identity.

We looked at the following Scripture passages:

- Mark 10:42-45
- James 2:14-17

During the week, look for ways to encourage your teenager as he or she reflects on what they are learning. Consider using some of these prompts to start conversation.

- James says that faith without works is dead. What do you think a dead faith looks like?
- Would you be interested in doing a service project together?
- Who are some people in your life that you have been able to serve lately? (It might also be a good idea to share examples of how you have served lately.)
