

Hello again! We're on lesson 32 in The LIFE study this week. This week's lesson was a really awesome time of fellowship and learning. I hope your teenager enjoyed it. This week, the lesson was entitled "The Motivation For Engaging With Our Surroundings," and it focused on helping students know that that through engaging with their surroundings, they would ultimately lead people to Christ.

We looked at the following Scripture passage:

- 1 Corinthians 9:19-23

NEXT STEPS . . .

During the week, look for ways to encourage your teenager as he or she reflects on what they are learning. Consider using some of these prompts to start conversation.

- This week your teenager talked about envisioning specific people in their lives who don't have a saving relationship with Jesus, and to practically consider how they might engage with these people in order to draw them closer to Christ. Encourage your teenager to write down names of people they are doing with this. Pray through these names together. Share with them first names of people you are sharing with.
- Then ask, "What do you believe Paul meant by, 'I have become all things to all people?' What can we learn from this? What is this not saying to do?" (This week your student learned about not compromising on convictions in reaching people.)
- How important is the Gospel to you? How are you showing your friends it is your top priority?
