Hello! We're continuing The LIFE, our yearlong study of living as a follower of Jesus. This week's lesson was an opportunity to see how worship connects with discipleship. We hope that our love for Jesus results in a life of worship in every area of lives!

This week, the lesson was entitled "Worship Is A Response to Who God Is," and we hope it helped our students see that worship is defined as a right response to an encounter with God.

We looked at the following Scripture passages:

- Psalms 136:1-9
- Luke 7:11-17

These passages are examples of disciples' response to God in worship. One of the big ideas of this lesson is that worship can be so many other things than just singing songs to God. Worship through song is a big part of our response to Jesus, but it shouldn't be the only one. As we live our lives for Jesus, we can worship in any area of our life by following Him.

I'll be praying for you and your families this week as you live lives of worship to God, together!

NEXT STEPS . . .

During the week, look for ways to encourage your teenager as he or she reflects on what they are learning. Consider using some of these prompts to start conversation.

- What are some ways or specific times that you have encountered God? Where were you? What were you doing? Do you feel like God told you something? (Take the time to share with your child some moments from your own faith story where you have encountered God.)
- What are some ways that we can worship together? (This may be something like incorporating some Scripture or music into your daily school trips, or praying together at the end of the day. Any time we are acknowledging God we are worshipping Him.)
- What is worship? (During this lesson, we defined worship as a right response to an encounter with God. Discuss this definition with your child and talk about the different ways that we respond to what God has done.)
