Hello! Over the past few weeks we've helped our students define worship, and had the chance to really think about the impact that praising and worshipping God can have on their lives. In this week's lesson we went a bit deeper into the practice of worship by looking at the two ways in which we lift songs of praise to God. So many of our students only think of worship as what they do on Sunday mornings with the greater congregation. But there is a personal aspect of worship that, for a Christ-follower, can't be overlooked. This lesson hopefully helped students understand the vital aspect of personal worship, as well as the importance of corporate worship.
