- What are some ways you are being (or can be) intentional in sharing your faith with your friends? Share with them how you are doing the same. Ask for specific, practical ways they are doing this.
- Read Matthew 28:18-20 together and then encourage your child to memorize it. Even better, memorize it with him or her.
