Parenting Conference this Month!

Parenting is hard.

I used to know a lot about raising kids. Until I had kids. Now, 13 years into this parenting thing, I'm keenly aware of all that I still don't know. If that weren't enough, my little kids are quickly becoming big kids, and I'm quite confident that I'm not ready.

Maybe you've felt like I do. Like you really don't know what you're doing. Like you're in way over your head. Maybe you've wondered whether God's Word has any help for you as you seek to raise your kids to know and follow Jesus.

I have good news. God has not left us to figure things out on our own. He has given us everything we need for life and godliness in His Word. That includes raising our kids to know and follow Jesus. That's why I'm so excited about our parenting conference at Goshen on February 20-21.

We are hosting Tate and Wendy Cockrell as they help us discover what it looks like to raise our kids to know and follow Jesus. Dr. Tate Cockrell is the director of the Doctor of Ministry program and biblical counseling professor at Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary in Wake Forest, NC. He and his wife Wendy lead marriage and parenting conferences all over the United States and have helped countless families follow Jesus through marriage and parenting.

The conference begins on Friday, February 20 with dinner at 5:30pm. The first session kicks off at 6:30pm. The Friday night session will focus on biblical foundations for Christian parenting and parental transitions from childhood to teen years. Doors will open Saturday, February 21 at 8:30am with donuts for breakfast. The session will begin at 9am with dismissal at 12pm. The Saturday morning session will focus on overcoming kid centric families, connecting with the heart of your teenager, and discipline and boundaries.

As you can see, the schedule is jam-packed with helpful topics that I believe will be beneficial for parents, grandparents, and those who minister to parents and grandparents (which includes all of us!). I want to encourage you to register now for the conference. You can also register for the course without purchasing the book. The charge for the book is \$30, and it will be used for all three Systematic Theology courses. There is no charge for the course if you do not want a copy of the book. You can also purchase the book on your own.

Puerto Rico Mission Trip...Registration for our 2026

Puerto Rico Mission Trip is now open. You can register in the church app. The trip is July 6-13. We will be serving Iglesia Bautista Castillo Fuerte by doing work on their church property and building to include yard work, pressure washing, painting (inside and out), and light interior construction to prepare classrooms using existing space. We will be working with church planters Christian and Valeria Acevedo and their young church in Gurabo. The cost of the trip is \$900. This will include airfare, lodging, ground transportation, and most meals. You will need spending money for purchasing any meals you may need during travel. Financial assistance may be available if needed. If you are unable to go but are interested in providing financial assistance for someone else to go, please contact Pastor Adam. A deposit of \$150 is required to secure your spot for the trip so that we can go ahead and purchase airfare. Three remaining payments of \$250 each will be due by March 29, April 26, and May 31. Payments should be made by placing your payment in the church offering plate or by turning it in to the church office. Please label all payments as "Puerto Rico Mission trip."
