A BRIEF HISTORY

The Calvary Chapel family of churches began in the late 1960's in a time where people were searching to belong to, or identify with something or someone. A movement in our country, commonly referred to the "Jesus Movement" was taking place, where people began to identify with Jesus through a personal relationship with Him. Pastor Chuck Smith was pastoring a small non-denominational church of about 25 people in Costa Mesa, California, serving with his wife, Kay. The Holy Spirit impressed upon their hearts a sensitivity to be open to the work that the He was doing, introducing many to who Jesus is, and discipling them to grow in relationship with Him.

Both Pastor Chuck and Kay served the Lord faithfully for many years and have since gone home to be with the Lord. Calvary Chapel of Costa Mesa today is a church home to thousands of people. Additionally, there are over 1,000 autonomous Calvary Chapel churches spanning across the world. Here at Calvary Church in Aurora, we are privileged to be a part of this movement of the Lord as our heritage, as we look to the Holy Spirit in the fresh work that He desires to do today and into the future.

A BALANCE

There are essential doctrines that we will always hold to: the infallibility of God's Word, the virgin birth of Jesus, His sinless life, His death for our sins, His bodily resurrection, His ascension to glory, and His personal return to rule the earth.

As a church we have a balance between the fundamentalism that has preserved the integrity of God's Word, but can potentially become rigid, legalistic, and unaccepting of the Spiritual Gifts, and the hyper-emotionally driven Pentecostal movement. We are centered around verse-by-verse teaching of God's Word and open to the gifts of the Holy Spirit operating freely under the leadership of mature Christians.

CHURCH GOVERNMENT

We believe that the pastor is responsible for the church, responsible to hear from God, and responsible to feed and love God's people faithfully. Assistant pastors have been raised up and help the pastor in the spiritual care of the people. A board of elders have been appointed to help the pastor care for the practical needs of the church, advising the pastor in regard to the business operations and decisions.

WORSHIP

Calvary Chapels vary in musical worship style. Some are quite traditional, while others are more contemporary. Our church is diversely made up of differing ages, styles and races. We simply come together with one common focus: love for Jesus and the desire to know Him more intimately, worshipping Him with a genuine heart.

ACTS 2:46-47

Behind each number is a name and behind each hand is a heart. It's not about how many people come to our church; it's about how many lives are changed.

Acts 2:46-47 (NKJV) So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they are their food with gladness and simplicity of heart. praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

When God makes Calvary your spiritual home, we want you to encounter Him here! Sure you will connect with others, do life together, and serve people, but what you really need is a true encounter with God. We've seen incredible growth here over the years. 1 Peter 2:17 (NKJV) Honor all people. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the king.

Honor and respect have been largely lost in our current culture. Disrespect, contempt, and disparagement have taken their place. When we speak of honoring people we mean respecting them. We want to treat people with the value and honor that God Himself placed upon them. Within the Body, your brothers and sisters are sons and daughters of the King! 2 CORINTHIANS 9:5

Calvary Church has been formed as a fellowship of believers in the Lordship of Jesus Christ. Our supreme desire is to know Christ and be conformed to His image by the power of the Holy Spirit. We are not a denominational church, nor are we opposed to denominations as such; only to the over-emphasis of the doctrinal differences that have lead to the division of the Body of Christ. We believe that the only true basis of Christian fellowship is Christ's (Agape) love, which is greater than the differences we possess, and without which we have no right to claim ourselves Christians.

DOCTRINAL

- **1. We believe** in what is termed "The Apostles' Creed" as embodying all the fundamental doctrines of orthodox evangelical Christianity.
- 2. We believe there is one living and true God, eternally existing in three persons; the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, equal in power and glory; that this triune God created all, upholds all, and governs all.
- **3. We believe** in God, the Father, an infinite, personal Spirit, perfect in holiness, wisdom, power, and love; that He concerns Himself mercifully in the affairs of men; that He hears and answers prayer; and that He saves from sin and death all who come to Him through Jesus Christ.
- **4. We believe** in Jesus Christ, God's only begotten Son, conceived by the Holy Spirit. We believe in His virgin birth, sinless life, miracles, and teachings; His substitutionary atoning death; bodily resurrection; ascension into heaven; perpetual intercession for His people; and personal, visible return to earth. We believe that He is one and the same as God. He was fully human and fully God.
- 5. We believe in the Holy Spirit who was sent to convict the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment and to regenerate, sanctify, and empower in ministry all who believe in Christ. We believe the Holy Spirit indwells every believer in Jesus Christ and that He is an abiding Helper, Teacher, and Guide. We believe that Jesus Christ baptizes the seeking believer with the Holy Spirit and power for service, either at the time of or subsequent to regeneration, which is a separate work from the indwelling Spirit for salvation. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit and in the exercise of all biblical gifts of the Spirit as reflected through the fruit of that same Spirit in the Holy Spirit, who came forth from the Father and Son.

- **6. We believe** that all the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are the Word of God, fully inspired and without error in the original manuscripts, and that they are the infallible rule of faith and practice.
- **7. We believe** all people are by nature separated from God and responsible for their own sin, but that salvation, redemption, and forgiveness are freely offered to all by the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. When a person repents of sin and accepts Jesus Christ as his/her personal Lord and Savior, trusting Him to save, that person is immediately born again and sealed by the Holy Spirit, all of his/her sins are forgiven, and that person becomes a child of God, destined to spend eternity with the Lord.
- 8. We await the pre-tribulation rapture of the church, and we believe in the literal Second Coming of Christ with His saints to rule the earth, which will be personal and visible. This motivates us to holy living, heartfelt worship, committed service, diligent study of God's Word, regular fellowship, participation in adult baptism by immersion, and Holy Communion.
- **9. We are neither** Five-Point Calvinists, nor are we Arminians. We adhere firmly to the biblical teaching of God's sovereignty and man's responsibility. We avoid any theological systems of belief that go beyond the written Word and thereby divide the body of Christ.
- 10. We do not believe in "positive confession" (the faith movement belief that God can be commanded to heal or work miracles according to man's will); human prophecy that supersedes the Scriptures; the incorporation of humanistic and secular psychology into biblical teaching; the overemphasis of spiritual gifts and experiential signs and wonders to the exclusion of biblical teaching; or that true Christians can be demon-possessed.
- **11. We believe** in the universal Church, in the living spiritual body, of which Christ is the head and all regenerated persons are members.
- **12. We believe** the Lord Jesus Christ committed two ordinances to the Church: 1) baptism, and 2) the Lord's Supper. We believe in baptism by immersion and communion, both of which are open to all believers in Jesus Christ.
- **13.** We believe in the laying on of hands for the sending out of pastors and missionaries, and in conjunction with the anointing of oil by the elders for the healing of the sick.

PRACTICAL

- **14.** We believe the only true basis of Christian fellowship is Christ's (agape) love, which is greater than the differences we possess, and without which we have no right to claim ourselves Christians.
- **15. We believe** worship of God should be spiritual; therefore, we remain flexible and yielded to the leading of the Holy Spirit to direct our worship.
- **16.** We believe worship of God should be inspirational; therefore, we give great place to music in our worship.
- 17. We believe worship of God should be intelligent; therefore, our services are designed with great emphasis upon the teaching of the Word of God that He might instruct us on how He should be worshiped. We seek to teach the Word of God in such a way that its message can be applied to the individual's life, leading that person to a greater maturity in Christ. We teach both expositionally and topically.
- **18.** We believe worship of God should be fruitful; therefore, we look for His love in our lives as the supreme manifestation that we have been truly worshiping Him.
- **19.** We believe that the church government should be simplistic rather than a complex bureaucracy and we depend on the Holy Spirit to lead, rather than on fleshly promotion.
- **20.** We believe that the Bible clearly delineates that spiritual gifts are for the edification of the body and that they are to be exercised in love. We believe that love is more important than the most spectacular gifts, and without love, all exercise of spiritual gifts is worthless. In our services, we focus on a personal relationship with God through worship, prayer, and the teaching of the Word of God. We do not practice speaking in tongues during worship or while a Bible study is in progress because we do not believe that the Holy Spirit would interrupt Himself. God is not the author of confusion. These gifts are encouraged in more intimate settings, e.g. personal prayer times, and afterglow services where their benefit can accomplish the purpose for which they have been given the edification of the body of Christ.

Mark 10:45

Consistent servanthood was Jesus' style of ministry and so it must be ours (John 13:35). If we see something that needs to be done we can simply chip in and do it. It's been said that the way up in God's Kingdom is to be the servant of all.



Who is Calvary Church?

Calvary Church is a non-denominational church that welcomes people from all backgrounds. We held our first Sunday morning service on December 26, 1999. We believe and teach that the Bible is God's Word and should be taken seriously. Calvary Church is a part of the Calvary Chapel family of churches; for more information about us, please visit our web site at www.CalvaryCO.church.



When are your service times?

We have three weekend services and one mid-week service:

- Saturday evening at 6 pm
- Sunday mornings at 8:45 am and 10:45 am
- Wednesday evening at 7 pm

We also have various small group ministries that meet throughout the week, almost every day of the week. More information is available at the Welcome and Ministry Centers and on our web page, www.calvaryCO.church.

You can also hear Pastor Ed several times on 89.7 GraceFM, Calvary Church's radio ministry outreach, teaching "Abounding Grace." You can also listen from anywhere in the world by visiting our web page, graceFM.com.

How many people call Calvary Church home?

Our small fellowship has grown rapidly over the past several years and we continue to see the Lord add to His number weekly. It's an amazing privilege to be a part of His work in this church!



What is expository teaching and does Calvary Church really teach through the whole Bible?

Because God gave man all 66 books in the Bible, we believe it's essential that we study every single book, chapter by chapter, verse by verse, from Genesis to Revelation. We are not opposed to topical studies and use them at different times throughout the year. However, like the apostle Paul, we want to say one day soon, "I have not shunned to give you the whole counsel of God." At Calvary Church, you can expect to receive a solid Bible study at every service.

Why don't you take a formal offering?

We are not opposed to formal offerings and find that on certain occasions a formal offering may be taken. However, we firmly believe that where God guides, He is always faithful to provide. We also believe that those who call Calvary Church their spiritual home should give generously and wholeheartedly to support the ministry. We provide offering boxes at various locations in the sanctuary for you to give unto the Lord your tithes and offerings so that your giving becomes an act of worship between you and Him alone.

Are there programs for my children and teenagers?

Yes, we offer classes every service for children nursery age through 6th grade. The Jr. High meets during all services on the third floor in the youth room. High School meets Saturday nights only at 6pm. Do you have adequate nursery facilities?

Yes, our nursery staff provides a safe atmosphere of love for infants and toddlers during every service. As a ministry team, we diligently try to make your children feel safe, nurtured, and loved.

Do you baptize babies?

No, however, we do publicly dedicate babies to the Lord. We do not believe the Scriptures tell us to baptize children who are not old enough to make a willful profession of Jesus as Savior. Parents can pick up a baby dedication packet in the bookstore or call the church and speak to a pastor for information on baby dedications.

Why are children dedicated to the Lord?

The act of publicly dedicating children is an encouragement to the parents and the entire church as the family commits their home and children before the congregation. The congregation agrees to accept responsibility to help the parents raise the children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

If I have already accepted Jesus Christ and have been baptized by immersion in another independent or denominational church, will I have to be baptized again? No, however, some people who recommit their lives choose to be baptized again if they feel their first baptism was for the wrong reason, such as an adult who was baptized as a child and may not have understood what they were doing at the time.

Can I get involved serving right away?

Most ministries require that you attend Calvary Church for at least six months prior to making a service commitment. This time allows you to get comfortable with the ministry here while capturing the overall vision of what God is doing through Calvary Church. It also gives us time to get to know you better and help you in finding your fit in the church. Overall we desire that you receive the Word of God and plug into one of the smaller group ministries. As you do, the time will fly by!

Where is the greatest ministry need and how can I get involved?

Our Children's Ministry definitely has the greatest need for people to teach or assist the teachers. You can contact childrens@calvaryco.church or 303-628-7200 to get involved with our Children's Ministry. Stop by the Ministry Center for other opportunities within the fellowship to serve.

What kind of "fellowship getaways" does the church have?

Each year we have several retreats or camps which are hosted by various ministries including the Women's Ministry, Men's Ministry, Marriage Ministry, and other ministries as the Lord leads. Every retreat is a spiritual blessing where we fellowship and focus on Jesus and His Word, leaving encouraged and refreshed.

Do you offer counseling?

We do not offer long-term counseling; however, we do have gifted spiritual leaders available to offer Biblical advice and spiritual encouragement. We also strongly suggest getting involved in a small group and becoming accountable to the Lord along with other believers. Contact the church office 303-628-7200 for more information.

Does the church have a prayer chain?









