

**Baptist Men's Day:** Our guest speaker is the Missions Mobilization Consultant for Baptists on Mission, Jay Baugham. He began his time with Baptists on Mission in 2013 with his wife, Ashley, at the Red Springs Mission Camp. In January 2019, they moved to Lumberton as the coordinators of the Lumberton Rebuild Center. Jay became the Missions Mobilization Consultant in 2025. He has been on and led many missions trips and has served in many roles at his church. His passion is serving God, bringing people hope and equipping others to do the same. **Google, what is a Baptist Man?** A Baptist man is a male follower of Jesus Christ within the Baptist Christian tradition, characterized by core beliefs like salvation by faith alone, the Bible as ultimate authority, believer's baptism by full immersion, and autonomy of local churches, often actively involved in church life and mission (like North Carolina Baptist Men's ministries) to serve others and grow spiritually.

**Google, what are Baptist Men?** Baptist Men are Christian men within Baptist churches organized to serve God through missions, discipleship, and fellowship, often under state conventions like NC Baptists on Mission (NCBM), focusing on practical service (ramps, disaster relief, work projects) and spiritual growth (study, evangelism) to be "hands and feet of Jesus" in their communities and globally. They connect local church efforts with broader mission opportunities, equipping men for ministry through training and shared experiences.
