JR CAMP RULES OF BEHAVIOUR

We respect God, our camp and each other.

We treat others kindly:

1. No hitting, biting, scratching, pinching, kicking.
2. No name calling, picking on or laughing at others, or using words that hurt others.
3. We treat others the way we would like to be treated.

We work and play safely.

We are polite:

1. Only one person talks at a time.
2. We listen when others talk.
3. We don't talk with food in our mouth.
4. We remember to say please and thank you.
5. We sing during singing time.
6. We obey the staff, the counselors, and the rules.

Leaders and children will be treated with respect and patience.

If a child is causing ongoing distraction, hitting or hurting someone, they shall be taken out of the situation by the staff, talked to and then allowed to return. If the problem persists, the child shall be taken from the group and talked to by the Camp Director. Parents will be notified of misbehavior so that efforts can be made at both home and Camp to modify the behavior.
