

I OFFER, I GIVE...

“...nor will I offer burnt offerings to the Lord my God with that which costs me nothing.”
2 Samuel 24:24 NKJV

So often when challenged to give more we pull out the “Leftover List” from our pockets. From times of prayer and fasting, to volunteering or giving our finances we may look first at what we have left. What would fit into our schedules, what’s most comfortable.
